

REGULATIONS UNDER THE UNDERGROUND WATERS
PRESERVATION ACT, 1969

*At the Executive Council Office, at Adelaide,
this 15th day of January, 1970*

BY virtue of the provisions of the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969, and all other enabling powers, I, the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby make the regulations set out hereunder.

Regulations Under the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969

1. These regulations may be cited as the "Underground Waters Preservation Regulations, 1970."

2. The regulations made under the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1959-1966, on the 19th day of January, 1967, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the same day at page 145, as varied by the regulations made on the 1st day of June, 1967, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the same day at page 1710, and the regulations made on the 14th day of December, 1967, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the same day at page 2541, and the regulations made on the 16th day of January, 1969, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the same day at page 167, are hereby revoked.

3. In these regulations—

"the Act" means the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969;

"the Minister" means the person for the time being holding or acting in the office of Minister of Mines.

4. The areas specified in the Schedule One hereto are prescribed as Defined Areas for the purposes of the Act.

5. All non-artesian wells, which are or will be less than the depth prescribed in Schedule Two hereto, within the areas prescribed in Schedule One as Defined Areas, are exempted from the provisions of the Act.

6. Every notice sent to the Minister pursuant to section 7 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule Three hereto and shall contain all information indicated as required in the said form, provided however, that any person who has fully complied with the provisions of section 6 of the Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1959-1966, need only supply such information as the Minister, by letter or notice, specifically requests.

7. Application for a permit under section 9 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule Four hereto, and shall contain all the information indicated as required in the said form.

8. A permit issued pursuant to Part II of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule Five hereto.

9. The return required by section 19 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule Six hereto and shall contain all information indicated as required in the said form.

10. (1) A person engaged in operations for the drilling or construction of a well for which a permit has been issued shall keep the following records and samples and shall, within 14 days of the completion or abandonment of such work, forward the records, copies of which shall be supplied to the permit holder, and samples to the Minister, provided however, that the Minister or an authorized person may at any time inspect the records and samples or request that they be forwarded to the Minister at such other time as he may think fit:—

- (a) Representative samples of not less than $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. weight taken at each change of strata observed in the well, and in any case at intervals not exceeding 10ft. of advance of the well. Such samples to be enclosed in a suitable container, and to be clearly marked so as to identify the well and depth at which the sample was taken.
- (b) A representative sample of not less than 26 fl. oz. weight of each water cut in the well preserved in a suitable bottle and clearly marked so as to identify the well and the depth at which the sample was taken.
- (c) Records showing details of:—
 - (i) The depth at which water was cut and the level at which water stands below ground surface.
 - (ii) Casing inserted in the well.
 - (iii) Daily progress of drilling in each calendar week.
 - (iv) Construction methods used.

(2) The records required to be kept pursuant to paragraph (c) of this regulation shall be in the form set out in Schedule Seven hereto.

11. Where a meter has been supplied or installed on any well by or at the expense of the Minister, the owner and occupier of the land upon which the well is situated shall be jointly and severally liable to pay to the Minister an annual service charge, the amount of which shall be determined by the Minister.

12. (1) Application for a Well Driller's Licence shall be made in the form set out in Schedule Eight hereto, and shall contain all information indicated as required in the said form.

(2) The prescribed fee for a Well Driller's Licence shall be \$10 and shall be payable upon the making of the application for the licence, but shall be refunded if the application is refused.

(3) The prescribed fee for the renewal of a Well Driller's Licence shall be \$10.

(4) Where the holder of an unexpired Well Driller's Licence applies for a variation of any of the conditions of his licence, he shall pay a fee of \$3, which shall not be refundable.

13. A Well Driller's Licence issued pursuant to Part IV of the Act shall contain conditions—

- (a) specifying the area or areas in which the licensee may operate;
- (b) setting out the types of drilling equipment which may be operated by the licensee in such areas;
- (c) stipulating the types of wells on which the licensee may work in such areas;

and shall be in the form set out in Schedule Nine hereto.

14. (1) The Well Driller's Examination Committee shall cause examinations for a well driller's licence to be held from time to time and may require an applicant for a Well Drillers' Licence to undertake such examination as the committee may think fit.

(2) The subjects of examination shall comprise:—

- (a) Drilling.
- (b) Casing.
- (c) Cementing.
- (d) Screens and packers.
- (e) Development.
- (f) Pumps.
- (g) Safety.
- (h) Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969.
- (i) These regulations.
- (j) Such other subjects as the Well Driller's Examination Committee may from time to time deem necessary.

15. The Well Driller's Examination Committee may exempt any applicant for a well driller's licence from the obligation to pass any examination as aforementioned if the applicant satisfies the committee that he is sufficiently qualified in the subject of the examination.

16. If the Minister is satisfied that the original has been lost or destroyed he may—

- (1) upon payment of a fee of \$1, issue a duplicate permit in lieu of the original;
- (2) Upon payment of a fee of \$2 issue a duplicate Well Driller's Licence in lieu of the original.

17. Any person supplying any information upon any of the forms prescribed by these regulations shall use all practical diligence to ensure that the information so supplied is accurate.

18. A person shall not knowingly make any false statement in or in connection with any application for a permit or licence under the Act or these regulations.

19. Any person contravening or failing to comply with any of the provisions of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$100.

thence northerly along the said hundred boundary to a point in line with the northern boundary of section 863, hundred of Mudla Wirra; thence easterly across road to the north-western corner of section 863; thence easterly along the northern boundary of sections 863, 864, 638, 639, 643, 644, 647, 782, 781 and 780 crossing intervening roads to the north-eastern corner of the latter section; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of section 780 to a point in line with the northern boundary of section 500; thence easterly across road and along the northern boundary of sections 500, 66, 62 and 444 crossing intervening roads and railway to the north-eastern corner of the latter section; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of sections 444, 445 and 459, crossing intervening road to the southern corner of the latter section; thence south-westerly across road and along the south-eastern boundary of sections 458, pt. 457, 54, 456 and 453 to the southern corner of the latter section; thence south-westerly across road to the southern corner of section 455; thence southerly across road to the northern corner of section 724 thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of section 724 to the south-western boundary of railway land through that section; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of railway land through sections 724, 723 and 2 to its intersection with the north-western boundary of Overway Bridge Road intersecting the latter section; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of Overway Bridge Road and across Gosford Street to the intersection of its western boundary with the southern boundary of section 2; thence southerly across road and along the western boundary of road (Hillier Road) intersecting section 8 and the eastern boundary of closed road to the eastern corner of section 3222, hundred of Munno Para; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of section 3222 to a point in line with the eastern boundary of section 75; thence southerly across road and along the eastern boundary of sections 75, 74, 68, 42, 89 and 41 crossing intervening roads and railway to the northern boundary of section 3218; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said section to its eastern corner; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of sections 3218, 3214, 3209, 3206, 3201, 3198, 3193, 3190, 3182, 1717, 1718, 1719, 3172, 3165, 3162, 3157, 3154, 3149, 3146, 3141, 3135 and closed roads, crossing intervening roads to the southern corner of section 3135; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of sections 3136, 3129, 3123 and 3120 to the south-eastern corner of section 3120; thence southerly across road to the north-eastern corner of section 3112; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of section 3112 and the western boundary of a road intersecting section 3139 and across road to the north-eastern corner of section 2154; thence south-easterly across road and along the north-eastern boundary of sections 2154 and 3122 and across road to the northern corner of section 4400; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of closed road and section 3092 to the southern boundary of road intersecting section 3092; thence easterly along the southern boundary of said road and the northern boundary of section 3282 to the eastern corner of section 3282; thence south-westerly along the eastern boundary of sections 3282 and 4400 to the boundary of the hundred of Yatala; thence generally easterly along the said hundred boundary (Little Para River) to its intersection with a line being the production of the south-eastern boundary of section 2136, hundred of Yatala; thence south-westerly along the said line and the south-eastern boundary of sections 2136, 3055, 3053, 3052, 3049, 3048, part 3045, 521, 3044, 3001, 3005, 3008, 3015, 3018, 3027, part 97, 672, 671, 670, 669, 668, 667, 666, 665, 664, 663, 662, 661, 660, 659, 651, 618, 617, 616, 615 and part 97 to the northern boundary of railway land through part section 97; thence westerly along the northern boundary of railway land through part section 97 and section 2245, crossing intervening road to the western boundary of the latter section, thence continuing westerly across road and hundred boundary and along the northern boundary of railway land through sections 1000 and 1004, hundred of Port Adelaide to a point in line with the southern boundary of section 990; thence westerly through section 1004 and along the southern boundary of sections 990,

991, 992, 993, 433, 334, 455, 72, 454, 450 and 445 to the south-western corner of the latter section: thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of section 445 to its western corner; thence north-easterly and northerly along the north-western and western boundary of section 445 to the south-eastern boundary of part section 2019; thence generally south-westerly, northerly, easterly and southerly along the south-eastern and western boundary of part section 2019, the western boundary of section 918, and the northern and eastern boundary of part section 2019 to the northern boundary of section 445; thence easterly along the northern boundary of section 445 to its north-eastern corner; thence north-westerly and north-easterly along the western boundary of section 450 to its northernmost point; thence generally northerly and north-westerly along the coast of Gulf St. Vincent to the point of commencement.

AREA No. 2—KINGSTON-BEACHPORT

Comprising the whole of the hundreds of Lacepede, Murrabinna and Minecrow in the county of MacDonnell.

AREA No. 3—KINGSTON-BEACHPORT

Comprising the whole of the hundreds of Mount Benson, Rowka and Townsend in the county of Robe.

AREA No. 4—KINGSTON-BEACHPORT

Comprising the whole of the hundreds of Ross, Conmurra and Joyce in the county of Robe.

AREA No. 5—KINGSTON-BEACHPORT

Comprising the hundreds of Waterhouse, Bray, Smith and Fox in the county of Robe and the hundreds of Lake George and Symon in the county of Grey.

SCHEDULE TWO—PRESCRIBED DEPTH

Underground Waters Preservation Act, 1969

1. A depth of 25ft. is prescribed for Defined Area No. 1 in Schedule One of these regulations.
2. A depth of 70ft. is prescribed for Defined Area No. 2 in Schedule One of these regulations.
3. A depth of 200ft. is prescribed for Defined Area No. 3 in Schedule One of these regulations.
4. A depth of 300ft. is prescribed for Defined Area No. 4 in Schedule One of these regulations.
5. A depth of 450ft. is prescribed for Defined Area No. 5 in Schedule One of these regulations.




