Interpretation

1 In this regulation, "fish" means a freshwater species of

- (a) Order Petromyzoniformes (lampreys),
- (b) Class Osteichthyes (bony fishes),
- (c) Class Crustacea (crustaceans), or
- (d) Class Mollusca

and their eggs and juvenile stages but does not include

- (e) goldfish, or
- (f) species of ornamental tropical fishes.

Offences

2 A person commits an offence where he

- (a) has in possession,
- (b) transports, or
- (c) traffics in

live fish unless authorized by a permit or a licence.

Authorization by permit

3 A regional manager or a person authorized by a regional manager may issue a permit in accordance with this regulation on the terms and for the period he or she specifies authorizing a person to

- (a) possess,
 - (b) transport, or
 - (c) traffic in
- live fish.

Fee for authorization by permit

4 The fee for a permit issued under section 3 is \$25 and the habitat conservation trust fund surcharge to be paid is \$5.
