**FISHERIES RESOURCES (JURISDICTION AND  
CONSERVATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Act, makes the following Regulations –

**1. Citation.**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2012, and shall expire on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2013.

**2. Amendment of Regulation 35 of Sub. Leg., Vol. IV, Ch. 244 – 11.**

Regulation 35 of the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Regulations is amended –

- (a) by the renumbering of the paragraph as paragraph (1); and
- (b) by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (1), of the following new paragraphs (2) and (3) –

- “(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), no person shall take, land, possess, sell or offer for sale any fish commonly known as “the Nassau Grouper” during the period 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2012 to the 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2013, except where such taking or landing is carried out, with the written approval of the Director of Fisheries for scientific research purposes.
- (3) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall, during the period 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2012 to the 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2013, land any fish commonly known as “grouper” unless its head, tail and skin is intact.”.
