THE WILD BIRDS PROTECTION (EXTENSION OF
CLOSE SEASON) ORDER, 1994

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 11 of the Wild Birds Protection Act, the following Order is made -

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Wild Birds Protection (Extension of Close Season) Order, 1994.
- Repeals and replaces Schedule to Ch. 230. 2. The Schedule to the Act is repealed and replaced as follows -
- * S C H E D U L E** (Sections 2, 4, 6, 8 and 11)

NAME OF BIRDS	DURATION OF CLOSE SEASON
1. All wild birds other than those enumerated in items 2 and 3 of this Schedule.	The whole year
2. White Crowned Pigeon (<i>Columba leucocephala</i>), Zenaïda or Wood Dove (<i>Zenaida aurita</i>), Eurasian-collared or "Ringnecked" Dove (<i>Streptopelia decaocta</i>), Ringnecked Pheasant (<i>Phasianus colchicus</i>), Guinea Fowl (<i>Numida meleagris</i>).	1st March to 28th September
3. Mourning or "Florida" Dove (<i>Zenaida macroura</i>), Bob White Quail (<i>Colinus virginianus</i>), Chukar Partridge (<i>Alectoris g. aeca</i>), Wilson's or Jack Snipe (<i>Lapalia gallinago delicata</i>), Coot (<i>Fulicia americana</i>), all wild ducks and geese (Family Anatidae) except Whistling Duck (<i>Dendrocygna arborea</i>), Bahama Duck (<i>Anas bahamensis</i>), Ruddy Duck (<i>Oxyrua jamaicensis</i>). "	1st April to 28th September
