THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES ACT 1963.

(No. 50 of 1963).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries by section 5 of The Agriculture and Fisheries Act 1963 the following Rules are hereby made:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Marine Products (Fisheries) (Amendment) Rules 1966 and shall be read as one with the Marine Products (Fisheries) Rules 1954, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules.

2. Rule 7 of the principal Rules is hereby amended:—
- (a) by deleting the expressions "16th day of March" and "31st day of August" appearing in paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor respectively the expressions "1st day of April" and "31st day of July"; and
 - (b) by deleting the expressions "16th day of March" and "30th day of September" appearing in paragraph (2) thereof and substituting therefor respectively the expressions "1st day of April" and "31st day of July".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Rules provide that the Crawfish Close Season during which it is illegal to buy, sell, or offer for sale any fresh crawfish shall now begin on the 1st day of April and end on the 31st day of July.
