THE MARINE PRODUCTS (FISHERIES)
(AMENDMENT) RULES, 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5 of The Agriculture and Fisheries Act and all other powers hereunto enabling, the following Rules are hereby made: —

1. These Rules may be cited as The Marine Products (Fisheries) (Amendment) Rules, 1974 and shall be read and construed as one with The Marine Products (Fisheries) Rules, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules.

Citation and construction.

2. Paragraph (a) of Rule 17 of the principal Rules is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor

Revokes and replaces Rule 17 of Principal Rules.

“(a) A licensee who purchases crawfish shall not offer for sale or dispose of such crawfish unless he has submitted the same for inspection to such person or persons as the Minister may appoint and has paid in an inspection fee of three cents per pound (notwithstanding the form in which such crawfish are offered for sale or disposal) at the ports of Nassau, Miami in Florida and West Palm Beach in Florida, and at such other places as the Minister may designate;”
