1. This Order may be cited as the
DANGEROUS GOODS ORDER.

2. WHEREAS in my judgment it appears to me that the explosives set out in the schedule to this Order are of so dangerous a character that it is expedient for the public safety that they should not be manufactured, kept, imported, conveyed or sold other than under licence issued by me:

NOW THEREFORE **I, ALEXANDER ALBERT HUNTER**, Minister of Natural Resources, Commerce and Industry, hereby order that the explosives set out in the schedule to this Order shall not be manufactured, kept, imported, conveyed or sold except under and in accordance with a licence issued by me.
