STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

No. 112 of 1999

ORDER made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Cooperatives in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Plant Protection Act, Chapter 178 of the Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 1980-1990, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

(Gazetted 2nd October, 1999.)

WHEREAS, there is an outbreak of the Pink Mealybug, also known as *Maconellicoccus Hirsutus*, a plant pest, in the areas referred to in the Schedule hereto;

AND WHEREAS, it has become expedient to declare the affected areas as an infected plant area;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the

2. The area specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an infected plant area.

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

All areas in Belize City, and from Belize City extending northwards on the Northern Highway to its junction with the Burrell Boom Road, and from Belize City extending westwards past the junction of the Western Highway and the Coastal Plain Highway at La Democracia, at approximately Mile 30, then all the way westwards to the junction of the Western Highway with the Hummingbird Highway at approximately Mile 48 Roaring Creek Village just outside the City of Belmopan, then from there extending southwards on the Hummingbird Highway all the way to Armenia Village.
