

# STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

No. 47 of 1990

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*REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Industry and Natural Resources in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 11 of the Wildlife Protection Act 1981 (No. 4 of 1981) and all other powers thereunto him enabling.*

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1. This Order may be cited as the

## **SARTENEJA (CLOSED AREA FOR HUNTING) REGULATIONS, 1990**

2. The area more fully described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be an area closed for hunting.

3. The hunting of any wildlife of any species in the said area is hereby prohibited. The contravention of the foregoing provisions of this regulation shall constitute an offense and the offender shall be liable to punishment on summary conviction by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars or imprisonment not exceeding six months or both such fine and imprisonment.

**SCHEDULE**  
**SARTENEJA (CLOSED FOR HUNTING AREA) COROZAL**  
**DISTRICT**

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land lying and being in the Corozal District and being now or formerly National Lands and hereinafter, referred to as the 'SARTENEJA NO HUNTING AREA' and bounded on the North by the Chetumal Bay, a 3,000 acres parcel of land and Block No. 262; In the East by the Caribbean Sea; On the South by Block No. 261 and on the West by Block No. 263 and containing approximately 36,270 acres as shown on Government Property Map and D.O.S. No. 13, Series E 755 (D.O.S. 4499) Edition 2 D.O.S. 1975 lodged in the Office of the Commissioner of Lands and Surveys, Belmopan and being more particularly described as follows:—

Commencing at the southwest corner of block No. 262; thence on a true bearing of N 72° 22' 00" E for a distance of 6.63 miles to a point on the seacoast; Thence easterly along the Seacoast for a distance of 2.98 miles to a point; thence due south for a distance of 2.97 miles to a point; thence due East for a distance of 1.52 miles to a point; thence due North for a distance of 2000 feet approximately to a point on the Northwestern Bank to Shipstern Lagoon; thence in a Northeasterly direction along the Sand Bank of the said Lagoon for a distance of 3.55 miles to a point; thence due North for a distance of 2.31 miles to a point on the Seacoast; thence in an easterly direction along the Seacoast for a distance of 2.17 miles to a point on Rocky Point; thence due South along the Seacoast for a distance of 13.02 miles to a point on Condemned Point; thence on a true bearing of N 83° 26' 00" W for a distance of 8.90 miles back to the point of commencement.
