



Ordinance amending and supplementing Ordinance No. 75 of 2006 laying down conditions and a list of requirements for the health status of propagating material of ornamental plants

Ordinance amending and supplementing Ordinance No 75 of 2006 laying down conditions and a list of requirements for the health status of propagating material from ornamental plants (promulgated, State Gazette, issue 50 of 2006, amended, issue 22 from 2007)

§ 1. In Art. 2, the following amendments are made:

1. The current text becomes para. 1.

2. Para. 2 and 3:

"(2) The planting material of the Palmae family of the genera and species listed in the Annex with a stem diameter of more than 5 cm shall meet one of the following requirements:

1. throughout its life cycle, be grown in an area defined as free from Rhynchophorus ferrugineus (Olivier) by the responsible official body in accordance with applicable international standards for phytosanitary measures;

2. in the last two years immediately prior to its placing on the market, has been grown in a place within the territory of the European Union which is physically completely protected by Rhynchophorus ferrugineus (Olivier) or in a place in the territory of the Union where the appropriate preventive measures against this pest; at least once every four months, a visual inspection shall be carried out in respect of the material in order to confirm that it is free from Rhynchophorus ferrugineus (Olivier).

(3) Paragraph 2 shall apply, without prejudice to the provisions on protected areas according to Art. 51 and Art. 11, para. 3 and 4 of Ordinance No 8 of 2015 on Phytosanitary Control (SG, No 19 of 2015). "

§ 2. In Art. 3, para. 2 the words "Art. 9 (1) of Directive 91/682, respectively 'shall be deleted.

§ 3. In Article 2 of the Additional Provisions, after the words "Council Directive 91/682 / EEC", the "Commission Implementing Directive (EU) 2018/484 of 21 March 2018 amending Directive 93/49 / as regards the requirements to be fulfilled for propagating material of certain genera and species of Palmae in connection with Rhynchophorus ferrugineus (Olivier) (OJ L 81 of 23 March 2018).

§ 4. In the Annex to Art. 2 after the words "Art. 2 "shall be added" para. 1 ", and in the table after row" Narcissus L. "the line" Palmae , with regard to the following genera and species " is created :
