TURTLES (PROTECTION) (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1986

[Gazetted 15/04, 1986]

The Governor in Council in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Turtles Act makes the following Notice.

Citation. 1. This Notice may be cited as the Turtles (Protection) (Amendment) Notice, 1986.

Amendment of paragraph 2 of SR&O 23 of 1959. 2. Paragraph 2 of the Turtles (Protection) Notice is amended by deleting the words "but not trunk turtles" and the comma preceding those words appearing in the second line thereof.

Repeal and replacement of paragraph 3 of SR&O 23 of 1959. 3. Paragraph 3 of the Turtles (Protection) Notice is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"Close Season.

3. The period between the 1st April and the 30th November, inclusive of both days, is appointed as the period during which it is unlawful for any person within the meaning of section 3 of the Ordinance

- (a) to catch or take or attempt to catch or take or cause to be caught or taken any turtle;
- (b) to slaughter any turtle or buy, sell offer or expose for sale or have in his possession the whole or any portion of the meat of any such turtle."
