

THE MARINE CONSERVATION LAW, 1978
(Law 19 of 1978)
THE MARINE CONSERVATION (MARINE PARKS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1988

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by sections 11 and 24 of the Marine Conservation Law, 1978, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Marine Parks) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988.

Amendment of reg. 5. 2. Regulation 5 of the Marine Conservation (Marine Parks) Regulations, 1986 is amended by adding the following new sub-regulation -

“(4) The entry, mooring, anchoring, and the discharge of passengers, without the approval of the Board, into or in the area at Bloody Bay-Jackson Point at Little Cayman designated as a marine park zone (being numbered 2H in the Second Schedule) by a commercial vessel, as defined in regulation 2 of the Marine Conservation Regulations, 1979, is prohibited. Such approval may be granted subject to whatever conditions the Board considers appropriate.”.
