

Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Leases Restrictions Amendment Regulations 2016.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on the day after the date on which they are made.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Leases Restrictions Regulations 1977 (as amended).
- 4 Approval may be given in certain cases**
(1) Regulation 19 is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (f)—

- “(g) The government of New Zealand and any agency of that government where—
- “(i) Cabinet has approved the use to which the leased land will be put; and
 - “(ii) that use is a public purpose within the meaning of section 364 of the Cook Islands Act 1915; and
 - “(iii) the occupational use of the lease cannot be varied.”
