AN ACT TO AMEND THE CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY ACT, No. 33 of 1967.

(Gazetted 28th August, 1975.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly of Dominica, and by the Authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the

CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1975. Short title.

2. The Central Water Authority Act No. 33 of 1967 is amended by replacing section 3(2) thereof with the following: Amendment of the Act.

“(2) The Central Water Authority shall consist of seven members designated Commissioners, who shall be appointed by the Minister, and who shall hold office for a period of three years, or for such shorter period as the Minister may determine, from amongst persons having knowledge of public health, forestry and lands, accounting, local government, law, business administration and engineering.”.
