STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 42 OF 1976.

REGULATIONS

MADE under section 15 of the Central Water Authority Act(a).

(Gazetted 4th November, 1976.)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the

**CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1976.**

Short title.

2. In these Regulations the Central Water Authority Regulations 1972 (S.R.O. No. 1 of 1973) are referred to as the Regulations.

Interpretation.

3. The First Schedule to the Regulations is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:—

FIRST SCHEDULE

*ANNUAL GENERAL WATER RATE* (Whether metered or not)

- (a) On houses with private water service and annual assessed value less than \$7,500 — none
- (b) On houses with private water service and annual assessed value \$7,501 — \$12,500 —  $\frac{1}{2}$ % of annual assessed value
- (c) On houses with private water service and annual assessed value greater than \$12,500 — 1% of annual assessed value.

4. The Second Schedule to the Regulations is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:—

SECOND SCHEDULE

*ANNUAL WATER SUPPLY RATE* (Unmetered Premises)

*Domestic Supplies*

- 1. With water supplied through a pipe with a bore of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch and annual assessed value of \$7,500 and less — \$52.00 per annum provided the building does not have fixtures in excess of:
  - (a) 1 kitchen sink, 1 lavatory basin, 1 water closet, 1 bidet, 1 shower and 1 bath tub; and
  - (b) 1 garden hose or outside hose connection.

For such buildings with the additional fixtures, additional charges shall be as follows:—

(c) For each urinal	\$ 1.80 per annum
(d) For each private garage when connected	9.00 " "
(e) Public garage (for each car)	9.00 " "
(f) For each additional sink, lavatory basin, bidet, faucet or tap	1.20 " "
(g) For each additional water closet	1.50 " "
(h) For each additional shower or bath tub	1.50 " "
(i) For each additional garden hose or other outside connection	9.00 " "

2. With water supplied through a pipe with bore greater than  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch and annual assessed value \$7,500 and less

(a) A pipe with bore of 4"	\$384.00 per annum
(b) " " " " " " 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 3"	216.00 per annum
(c) " " " " " " 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2"	144.00 " "
(d) " " " " " " 1" to 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ "	108.00 " "
(e) " " " " " " $\frac{3}{4}$ "	60.00 " "

Having

(a) Kitchen sink, lavatory basin, water closet, bidet, shower and bathtub	\$7.20 " "
(b) Each urinal	1.80 " "
(c) Each private garage with connection	9.00 " "
(d) Garden hose or other outside hose connection	9.00 " "
(e) Public garage (for each car)	9.00 " "
(f) For each additional sink, lavatory basin, bidet, faucet or tap	1.20 " "
(g) For each additional water closet	1.50 " "
(h) For each additional shower or bath tub	1.50 " "

3. With annual assessed value greater than \$7,500 and water supplied through:

(a) A pipe with a bore of 4 inches	\$512.00 per annum
(b) " " " " " " 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2"	288.00 " "
(c) " " " " " " 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2"	192.00 " "
(d) " " " " " " 1" to 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ "	144.00 " "
(e) " " " " " " $\frac{3}{4}$ "	80.00 " "
(f) " " " " " " $\frac{1}{2}$ "	48.00 " "

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Having

(a) Kitchen sink, lavatory basin, water closet, bidet, shower and bath tub	\$12.00 per annum
(b) Urinal each	2.40 " "
(c) Private garage when connected	12.00 " "
(d) Garden hose or other outside hose connection each	12.00 " "
(e) Public garage (for each car)	\$ 12.00 per annum
(f) For each additional sink, lavatory basin, bidet, faucet or tap	1.60 " "
(g) For each additional water closet	2.00 " "
(h) For each additional shower or bath tub	2.00 " "

4. Provided that the annual water rate shall not exceed \$104 for building with annual assessed value less than or equal to \$12,500.

### THIRD SCHEDULE

#### WATER SUPPLY RATE PREMISES (Metered)

- Domestic Supplies:
  - For the first 1,000 gallons or part thereof per quarter —  
\$ .70c.
  - For the next 10,000 gallons per 1,000 gallons or part thereof  
per quarter .80c.
  - For additional 1,000 gallons or part thereof per quarter —  
\$1.00.
- Non-domestic Supplies:
  - Commercial and Combination Domestic and Commercial  
(Metered)
  - For the first 10,000 gallons per 1,000 gallons or part thereof  
per quarter \$1.00.
  - For each additional 1,000 gallons or part thereof per  
quarter \$1.10.
- Industrial (Metered)
  - For the first 50,000 gallons per 1,000 gallons or part thereof  
per quarter — \$ .80c.
  - For each additional 1,000 gallons or part thereof per  
quarter — \$ .90c.

4. For public fountains or stand pipes charge per month each—\$15.00.

5. Private Fire Service and sprinklers for use only in case of fire charges will be based on the size of connections:

1" or less charge per month each	\$2.00
2" charge per month each	4.00
3" charge per month each	6.00
4" charge per month each	10.00

6. Water delivered to ships between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.—\$10.00 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof.

Water delivered to ships outside the above hours \$16.00 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof.

Amendment of  
the Fourth  
Schedule.

6. The Fourth Schedule to the Regulations is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:—

"Minimum charges for connections or reconnections, per 20' feet length of pipe to the boundary of the premises.

Reconnection For pipes of all bores	\$20.00."
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Commencement.

7. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1977.
