MADE by the St. Joseph Village Council under Section 18 of the Village Councils Ordinance(a) to provide for the control of slaughtering of livestock.

| <p>4. No person shall slaughter or cause to be slaughtered any livestock except—</p> <p>(a) at a place designated for such purpose by the Council, and</p> <p>(b) with the permission of the Officer.</p>   | <p>Restrictions on the slaughtering of livestock.</p>  |
| <p>5. Requests to the officer for permission to slaughter any livestock shall be made not less than seven days before the day on which the slaughtering is intended; however when the officer considers that the circumstances so warrant, he may waive this requirement.</p> | <p>Requests for permission to slaughter livestock.</p> |
| <p>6. Any person who contravenes Section 4 or 5 is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars and to imprisonment for six months.</p>   | <p>Penalty.</p>  |
