

**COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA**

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 37 of 1994

**ORDER**

MADE by the Minister under section 14(5) of the Carib Reserve Act, (Chap. 25:90).

(Gazetted 7th July, 1994.)

WHEREAS it is provided by section 14 subsection (5) of the Carib Reserve Act that the Minister shall three days before any general election of members held under the provisions of section 52 of the Act dissolve the Council;

AND WHEREAS Monday the 4th day of July, 1994 has been fixed as Election Day in respect of the Carib Reserve Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HENRY GEORGE, Minister for Community Development and Social Affairs, hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the – Short title.  
CARIB RESERVE COUNCIL (DISSOLUTION) ORDER 1994.
2. The Carib Reserve Council is dissolved on the 1st day of July, 1994. Dissolution of  
Carib Reserve  
Council.
3. Upon dissolution of the Council and until the newly elected Council first meets subsequent to the general elections of the Council all property real and personal belonging to or vested in the Council shall vest in the outgoing Chairman and Clerk of the Vesting of property,  
etc.

Council and all duties, liabilities and powers of the Council shall be discharged, exercised and performed by the outgoing Chairman and Clerk of the Council.
