**DEVELOPMENT LEVY (DOMINICA BANANA
MARKETING CORPORATION) REGULATIONS**

made under section 2

Commencement.
[7/1988].

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the –
**DEVELOPMENT LEVY (DOMINICA BANANA
MARKETING CORPORATION) REGULATIONS.**

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations –
“Corporation” means the Dominica Banana Marketing Corporation;
“levy” means the development levy authorised under section 2 of the
Act;
“Minister” means the Minister responsible for Finance.

Levy on bananas
sold.

3. There shall be deducted from the proceeds of sale of bananas
made by the Corporation a levy of one cent on each pound of bananas
sold where the price received by the Corporation per pound of bananas
exceeds fifty cents.

Additional levy
where price of
bananas exceeds
fifty-five cents
per pound.

4. At any time that the price received by the Corporation for
bananas sold exceeds fifty-five cents per pound, there shall be deducted
from such amount in excess of fifty-five cents per pound an additional
levy of twenty-five per cent of such excess amount.

Amount to be
paid to Comp-
troller.

5. All amounts payable as aforesaid from the proceeds of sales
made by the Corporation shall be paid to the Comptroller of Inland
Revenue within fifteen days after the end of each calendar month.

Extending
payment of levy.

6. The Minister may, if he is satisfied that it is just and equitable
to do so, suspend in whole or in part the payment of the levy or extend
the period for payment of the levy.
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
