STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 3 OF 2000

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under section 19 of the National Parks and Protected Areas Act, Chap. 42:02.

(Gazetted 13th January, 2000.)

**NATIONAL PARKS AND PROTECTED AREAS
(MORNE DIABLOTIN NATIONAL PARK) ORDER,
2000.**

2. In This Order, the National Parks and Protected Areas Act is referred to as "the Act".

Interpretation.

3. The Schedule to the Act is amended by inserting the following:

Amendment of
Schedule to the Act.

"MORNE DIABLOTIN NATIONAL PARK
Description of boundaries of the Morne
Diablotin National Park:

North: From point known as G170 on the plan of the Forest Reserve situated 5,000 feet northwest of Morne Turner in the heights of Syndicate, thence along a line traced on the ground in an easterly direction for a distance of 8,800 feet to a point known as G98.

East: From G98 the boundary goes in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 22,500 feet to a point due west of triangulation station T124 thence in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 5,000 feet to a point at the intersection of two tributaries of the Melville Hall River.

South: From the point at the intersection of two tributaries of the Melville Hall River, the boundary follows the southern or main tributary of the Melville Hall River in a westerly direction for a distance of 6,700 feet to a point due north of Mosquito Mountain, thence along a northern tributary of the Batali River in a westerly direction for a distance of 4,600 feet to a point known as E85 on the plan of the Forest Reserve.

West: From E85 the line goes in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 10,800 feet to a triangulation point on Morne Les Resources, then northwesterly for a distance of 3,150 feet to the Dublanc River, thence northerly for a distance of 5,300 feet to a point known as 3181, thence in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 1,380 feet to a point known as 3094 the southeastern boundary marker of the lands of Dorian Laudat.

From the point known as 3094 the boundary goes in a northwesterly direction along the eastern boundary of the land of Dorian Laudat for a distance of 550 feet thence along the boundary of the land of James Royer for a distance of 550 feet in a northwesterly direction partially along a ravine's course to a point known as 3101, thence in a westerly direction for a distance of 160 feet thence in a westerly direction for a distance of 220 feet along a road to the corner boundary of lands of Gerard Ambo and James Royer at a point known as 3127.

From the point 3127 the boundary goes in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 1,000 feet along a road to the corner boundary of land of Robinson Casimir and Gerard Ambo at a point known as 3131 thence in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 900 feet along the boundaries of lands of Robinson Casimir, Osborne Francis Bellot and Clementina Jane Bellot and Mc. Lean Casimir to a point known as 3115 thence in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 1,100 feet along the boundary of land of Daryl Ambo to a point known as 3042.

From point 3042 the boundary goes in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 1,400 feet along the boundary of Morne Plaisance Estate to a point, thence in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 1,350 feet to the corner boundary of Morne Plaisance Estate and the Remainder of Dyer's Estate at a point known as 3194 thence in an easterly direction for a distance of 600 feet along the

boundary of the remainder of Dyer's Estate to a point known as 3199 at the Picard River.

From the point known as 3199 the boundary goes along the Picard River in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 4,000 feet, thence northeasterly for a distance of 5,500 feet to the point known as G170.

The area enclosed comprises 8,242 acres and excludes approximately 237 acres of private land situated northwest of Morne Diablotin and owned by Rufus Paul, Vincent and Euville Daisy, Culson Roudette, David Fritz, Joseph and Lucia Peter, Marsden and Athenia Ravariere, Joseph Prosper, Keith Thomas, Alon Vidal, Daniel Joseph, Alixford Daniel, James Julien, Ross Charles, Gerald Charles, Patrick Vidal, Witnel Louis, Silson Laudat, Philomen Laudat, Ferdie Pierre-Louis, Alphonso Laudat, Curtis Charles, Paterson Laudat."
