STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 18 of 1996

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 7 and 8 of the Plant Protection and Quarantine Act, Chap 58:40.

(Gazetted 2nd May, 1996.)

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

PLANT PROTECTION AND QUARANTINE (PINK MEALY BUG/HIBISCUS MEALY BUG CONTROL) ORDER 1996.

2. In this Order –

Interpretation.

“specified States” means Grenada, St. Kitts and Trinidad and Tobago.

3. This Order is made in order to prevent the introduction of the PINK MEALY BUG/HIBISCUS MEALY BUG – MACONELLICOCCUS HIRSUTUS into the State.

Purpose of Order.

4. The importation of any plant, the part of any plant, any plant product or the fruit and vegetables of any plant from any specified State is prohibited.

No importation from specified States.

5. Any officer of the Plant Protection and Quarantine Service shall authorise and direct the seizure and destruction of any article imported into the State contrary to section 4.

Power of the Plant Protection and Quarantine Service.

Penalty.

6. Any person who obstructs any officer in the performance of his functions under section 4 commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars and seven days imprisonment.
