**Decree No. 46 (1967) - "Legal"**

**on**

**Determining the animals, meats, and animal products & by-products and infectious and contagious diseases governed by the provisions of veterinary quarantine**

The Minister of Agriculture

After considering Article 135 (Items : a) of Law No. 53 (1966) promulgating the Agricultural Law,

Decides :

**Article 1**

The provisions of veterinary quarantine shall apply to the following :

**a) Animals**

Bovines (cows, buffalo, camels) - Equines (horses, mules, donkeys), sheep, goats, hogs, dogs, cats, apes, monkeys, domestic animals (rabbits, geese, turkeys, chicken, pigeon), parrots and decorative birds of all species, fish, insects and sperm extracted from any such species, and wild animals according to counterpart.

**b) Animal products**

Raw meats, raw fish, eggs (consumption / hatching), biological material.

**c) Animal by-products**

Dung; droppings; blood; horn; hooves; hair; wool; camel-hair; skins / hides; fur;

**Article 2**

Contagious and epidemic diseases :

cattle plague (rinderpest); CBP : contagious bovine pleuro-pneumonia; contagious abortion (brucellosis); foot-and-mouth; membrane diseases; anthrax; glanders; epizootic

lymphangitis; African horse sickness; rabies; Newcastle's disease; CRD : chronic respiratory disease in fowl; fowl pest; psitacosis ornithosis; myxomatosis in rabbits; external parasites; yellow fever.

**Article 3**

This decree is to be published in the official Egyptian Gazette and is effective as of 11 March 1967.
