Ministerial Decree
No. 1403 of 1990

Deputy Premier and Minister of Agriculture
and Land Reclamation.

Having perused Article 117 of the Agriculture Law issued by Law No. 53 of 1966, and the Decree of the President of the Republic No. 187 of 1984, for establishing the General Organization for Veterinary Services,

The Ministerial Decree No. 28 of 1967, determining the species of domestic birds useful for agriculture and wild animals on which ban stipulated in Article 117 of the Agriculture Law is imposed,

The Ministerial Decree No. 1058 of 1984, banning the catch of some species of crocodiles and monitor lizard, and

The Ministerial Decree No. 21 of 1989, banning the catch of some wild animals, and what has been referred by the Chairman of the General Organization for Veterinary Services,

D E C I D E D

Article (1): The reptiles which species are stated in the attached list are banned from catch, slay or being caught by any mean, and it is not also permitted to be possessed, moved, roved with, sold or being put for sale, neither live nor dead.

The General Authority for Veterinary Services may exceptionally permit the transfer of samples of the said species for scientific or touristic purposes, on condition that such permit would not exceed five of each species.

Article (2): Capture of all species of reptiles (poisonous or non poisonous- rare or common) is banned during hibernation season, i.e. from October first till the end of March, and any type of dealing in it, is strictly forbidden.

Article (3): This Decree is to be published in the Egyptian Wakae, and would come into effect as of the date of publishing.
