Chapter 1 FORMATION OF HUNTING AREAS

§ 1. Area and boundary description of the Angus hunting area

§ 2. Give the area and boundary description of the hunting area

- (1) The area of the Anna hunting area is 13,520 hectares.
- (2) The boundary description of the Anna hunting area is as follows:

The Anna hunting area boundary runs from the intersection of the eastern boundary of the Sikkemäe property and the boundary line between Albu and Paide rural municipalities along the boundary line between Albu and Paide rural municipalities to the Jägala River, continuing along the Jägala River to the northwestern corner of block PD095 of the Järvamaa forest district; from there along the western direction of blocks PD095, PD096 and PD097 of the Järvamaa forest district to the Pärnu River and along the Pärnu River to the northwestern corner of block PD104 of the Järvamaa forest district; further along the northern and eastern directions of block PD104 of the Järvamaa forest district, the eastern directions of block PD118 and the eastern and southern directions of block PD120 to the Pärnu River; from here along the Pärnu River to the Lasputre stream and along the Lasputre stream to the southwestern corner of block PD164 of the Järvamaa forest district, continuing along the southern directions of blocks PD164 and PD165 to the Rakvere–Paide road; from there along the Rakvere–Paide highway to the Lasputre stream and along the Lasputre stream to the Vodja river; further along the Vodja river to the Tartu–Tallinn highway; then along the Tartu–Tallinn highway to the Mäo intersection; from here along the Mäo–Paide highway to the Paide city border, continuing westwards along the Paide city border to the Pärnu river and along the Pärnu river to the mouth of the Eivere main ditch; from the mouth of the Eivere main ditch along the Eivere main ditch to the southern end of the PD192 block of the Järvamaa forest district; then along the southern end of the PD192 and PD191 blocks of the Järvamaa forest district to the eastern border of the Prääma peat bog; further along the eastern and northern borders of the Prääma peat bog to the southern end of the PD181 block of the Järvamaa forest district; thence along the southern direction of Järvamaa Forest District block PD181 to the southwestern corner of block PD181, continuing along the western direction of Järvamaa Forest District blocks PD181, PD175 and PD171 to the Lithuanian main ditch and along the Lithuanian main ditch to the Reopalu River; from here along the Reopalu River to the Suuresaare road; then along the Suuresaare road to the Lintsi–Ussisoo road and along the Lintsi–Ussisoo road to the Tartu–Tallinn road; from the intersection along the Tartu–Tallinn road to the old Tartu–Tallinn road in the northwestern corner of Järvamaa Forest District block VT129; then along the old Tartu–Tallinn road to the new Tartu–Tallinn road at Matsimäe, continuing along the new Tartu–Tallinn road to the Mustla–Saarnakõrve road; then along the Mustla–Saarnakõrve road to the Lintsi River and along the Lintsi River to the southern boundary of the Tõrvaaugu property; further along the southern boundary of the Tõrvaaugu property to the Kasesalu road; from here along Kasesalu Road to the direction of Mustla bog; then along the direction of Mustla bog to the southwest corner of Järvamaa forest district block VT030; from there along the southwest direction of Järvamaa forest district blocks VT030 and VT029 to the southeast direction of Järvamaa forest district block VT027; then along the southeast direction of Järvamaa forest district blocks VT027, VT026, VT025 and VT024 to the northwest direction of Järvamaa forest district block VT031, continuing along the northwest direction of Järvamaa forest district block VT031 to the northeast direction of block VT031 and along the northeast direction of blocks VT031, VT032 and VT033 to the Reopalu River; then along the Reopalu River to the west direction of Järvamaa forest district block VT018; from there along the western direction of blocks VT018 and VT017 to the eastern border of the Sikkemäe property and along the eastern border of the Sikkemäe property to the border between Albu and Paide rural municipalities.

§ 3. Area and boundary description of the Ilumetsa hunting area

(1) The area of the Ilumetsa hunting area is 14,880 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Ilumetsa hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Ilumetsa hunting area runs from the Leevi settlement along the Rápina–Võru road to the Karisilla–Põlva road and along the Karisilla–Põlva road to the Veerksu stream, continuing along the Veerksu stream to the Väike-Veerksu–Kahkva–Orava road; from there along the Väike-Veerksu–Kahkva–Orava road to the Rebasmäe stream and along the Rebasmäe stream to the Kamnitsa–Ilumetsa road; then along the Kamnitsa–Ilumetsa road to the Kahkva–Lepassaare road; from the intersection along the Kahkva–Lepassaare road to the Lõo road and along the Lõo road to the southern border of the Lõo property; from here along the southern and western borders of the Lõo property to the Tuderna stream; then along the Tuderna stream to the Hanikase–Jantra road, continuing along the Hanikase–Jantra road to the Mudaküla road; from the intersection along the Mudaküla road to the Lepassaare–Viluste road; from there along the Lepassaare–Viluste road to the Kõrgessaare road and along the Kõrgessaare road to the Leevi–Lepassaare road, continuing along the Leevi–Lepassaare road to the Rápina–Võru road in the Leevi settlement.

§ 4. Area and boundary description of the Kaansoo hunting area

(1) The area of the Kaansoo hunting area is 14,100 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Kaansoo hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Kaansoo hunting area runs from the northern corner of Järvamaa Forest District block KB001 along the forest road located in block KB029 in the eastern direction of blocks KB001, KB003, KB005, KB008, KB011, KB015, KB019, KB023 and KB028 of Järvamaa Forest District; from there along the forest road, passing through blocks KB029, KB034, KB040, KB045, KB052, KB059, KB065 and KB077 of Järvamaa Forest District to the road junction in block KB085; from the road junction along the forest road to the Tõrvaugu–Võhma road, continuing along the Tõrvaugu–Võhma road to the Kabala Forest District office; from there along the Tõrvaugu–Jälevere road to the Navesti River, continuing along the Navesti River to the Suure-Jaani–Vändra road; further along the Suure-Jaani–Vändra road to the Vihiküla–Rääka road; from the intersection along the Vihiküla–Rääka road to the Labida road, continuing along the Labida road to the Võlli–Suure-Jaani road; from the intersection along the Võlli–Suure-Jaani road to the Võlli–Kibaru road, continuing along the Võlli–Kibaru road to Kibaru and northwest from Kibaru along the forest road to the eastern border of the Viljandimaa forest district block KB406; from here along the eastern border of the Viljandimaa forest district blocks SS014, SS010, SS009 and SS008 to the Arjadi stream, continuing along the Arjadi stream to the Navesti river and along the Navesti river to the Kaansoo stream; then along the Kaansoo stream to the Suure-Jaani–Vändra road; from there along the Suure-Jaani–Vändra road to the Kaansoo–Pärassaare road; from the intersection along Kaansoo–Pärassaare road to the western direction of block KB286 of the Järvamaa forest district, continuing along the western direction of blocks KB286, KB279 and KB270 to the southwestern corner of block KB262; then along the northwest direction of blocks KB262, KB254, KB246, KB237, KB227, KB218, KB198, KB180, KB158, KB143, KB134, KB111, KB091, KB081, KB072, KB060, KB054, KB047, KB035, KB030, KB025, KB020, KB017, KB013, KB010 and KB007 to the northwest boundary of the Sillajaagu property; then along the northwestern boundary of the Sillajaagu property to the northwest of block KB003 of the Järvamaa forest district, continuing along the northwest of blocks KB003 and KB001 to the northern corner of block KB001.

§ 5. Area and boundary description of the Kylmallicka hunting area

(1) The area of the Kylmallicka hunting area is 9,130 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Kylmallicka hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Kylmallicka hunting area runs from the intersection of the Tallinn–Pärnu and Kernu–Kohila roads along the Kernu–Kohila road to the Hageri–Kodila road; from the intersection along the Hageri–Kodila road to the Rabivere main ditch; further along the Rabivere main ditch to the Kasari River and along the Kasari River to the Jutapere stream; then along the Jutapere stream to the Mustu main ditch, continuing along the Mustu main ditch to the Mustu–Kustja–Haiba road; then along the Mustu–Kustja–Haiba road to the Kernu–Riisipere road; from the intersection along the Kernu–Riisipere road to the Mõnuste road and along the Mõnuste road to the Haiba–Pohla road; from here along the Haiba–Pohla road to the Kernu–Riisipere road, continuing along the Kernu–Riisipere road to the Tallinn–Pärnu road and along the Tallinn–Pärnu road to the Kernu–Kohila road.

§ 6. Area and boundary description of the Lasva hunting area

(1) The area of the Lasva hunting area is 9,880 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Lasva hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Lasva hunting area runs from the southwestern corner of the QB060 block of the Põlvamaa forest district on the banks of the Võhandu River along the southern direction of the block QB060 to the western direction of the QB063 block of the Põlvamaa forest district; further along the western direction of the QB063 and QB064 blocks of the Põlvamaa forest district to the northwestern corner of the QB071 block of the Võrumaa forest district; then along the northern direction of the QB071 and QB072 blocks of the Võrumaa forest district to the northeastern corner of the QB072 block, continuing along the northeastern direction of the QB072, QB076 and QB079 blocks of the Võrumaa forest district to the Eha road; from there along the Eha road to the Leevi–Lepassaare road, continuing along the Leevi–Lepassaare road to the Kõrgessaare road; then along the Kõrgessaare road to the Lepassaare–Viluste road; further along the Lepassaare–Viluste road to the Leevi–Lepassaare road, continuing along the Leevi–Lepassaare road to the Otsa–Lepassaare road; from the intersection along the Otsa–Lepassaare road to the Obinitsa–Võru road and along the Obinitsa–Võru road to the Võru–Petseri railway; from here along the Võru–Petseri railway to the Lindora–Lepassaare road, continuing along the Lindora–Lepassaare road to the border between Põlva and Võru counties and along the inter-county border to the Pelska–Hellekannu road; further along the Pelska–Hellekannu road to the Võru–Obinitsa road; from the intersection along the Võru–Obinitsa road to the Kõrgesilla–Loosi–Nõnovo road, continuing along the Kõrgesilla–Loosi–Nõnovo road to the Iskna River; from there along the Iskna River to the border between Võru and Lasva rural municipalities; from here along the border between Võru and Lasva rural municipalities to the Märssoo main ditch and along the main ditch to the Iskna River; further along the Iskna River to the Võhandu River and along the Võhandu River to the southwestern corner of the Põlva County forestry block QB060.

§ 7. Area and boundary description of the hunting area of the glaciers

(1) The area of the Luiste hunting area is 10,420 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the hunting area of the glaciers is as follows:

The boundary of the Luiste hunting area runs from Koluvere along the Koluvere–Märjamaa road to the Kiristu ditch (to the Jüri bus stop), continuing along the Kiristu ditch to the Loodna main ditch and along the Loodna main ditch to the Luiste ditch; from there along the Luiste ditch to Krahvi road; further along Krahvi road to the Klausimetsa ditch; then along Klausimetsa, Jõe and Kõki ditches to the Pokuti stream, continuing along the Pokuti stream to the Luiste river and along the Luiste river to the Kõrtsu ditch; from here along the Kõrtsu and Nurme ditches to the Nurme farm road; then along the Nurme farm road to the Silla–Jädivere road and along the Silla–Jädivere road to the Loodna–Vigala road; from the road junction along the Loodna–Vigala road to the Kasari river; further along the Kasari river to Laastre; from Laastre along the Laastre–Üdruma road to the Virtsu–Risti road and along the Virtsu–Risti road to Koluvere.

§ 8. Area and boundary description of the Lõõla hunting area

(1) The area of the Lõõla hunting area is 10,950 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Lõõla hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Lõõla hunting area runs from Saueaugu along the Saueaugu–Paide highway to the southwestern corner of the Järvamaa forest district block VT265, continuing along the southern direction of the Järvamaa forest district block VT265 to the Palivere direction and along the Palivere direction to the Palivere road; from there along the Palivere road to the Reopalu River and along the Reopalu River to the main ditch of Lithuania; further along the main ditch of Lithuania to the northeastern corner of the Järvamaa forest district block PD170; then along the eastern direction of blocks PD170, PD174 and PD180 to the southwestern corner of the Järvamaa forest district block PD181; from there along the southern direction of block PD181 to the Prääma peat bog, continuing along the northern and eastern border of the Prääma peat bog to the southwestern corner of the Järvamaa forest district block PD191; from there along the southern direction of blocks PD191 and PD192 to the main ditch of Eivere; further along the Eivere main ditch to the Pärnu River and along the Pärnu River to the southeast corner of block PD202 of the Järvamaa Forest District; then along the southern direction of block PD202 to the southeast corner of the Prääma peat bog, continuing along the southern border of the Prääma peat bog to the southeast corner of block PD201 of the Järvamaa Forest District; from there along the southern and western directions of block PD201 to the southeast border of the Prääma Sawmill property, continuing along the southeastern border of the Prääma Sawmill property to the southeast corner of block PD200 of the Järvamaa Forest District; then along the southern direction of block PD200 to the Reopalu River and along the Reopalu River to the Pärnu River, continuing along the Pärnu River to the border of the Kopliotsa property; from there along the direction to the Paide–Türi road; then across the road along the northern and western direction of Järvamaa Forest District block PD220 to the southeastern corner of the Mihkli II property, continuing along the southern direction of Mihkli II, Risti, Allika 2, Aru I, Aru-Põllu and Aru II properties to the Lokuta River; further along the Lokuta River to the southeastern corner of the Lassi property, continuing along the southern border of the Lassi property to the intersection of the Türi–Väätsa road and the Sõeru property boundary; then along the southern border of the Sõeru, Lepiku and Tüve properties to the southeastern corner of Järvamaa Forest District block TY017; from there along the southern and western direction of block TY017 to the southeastern corner of the Kõlli property; further along the southern border of the Kõlli and Raja properties to the Lintsi River, continuing along the Lintsi River to the southeastern corner of the Kõrgepingi property; from here along the southern border of the Kõrgepingi property to the Piumetsa–Vahastu road and along the Piumetsa–Vahastu road to Vahastu; From Vahastu along the Vahastu–Saueaugu road to Saueaugu.

§ 11. Area and boundary description of the Orava hunting area

(1) The area of the Orava hunting area is 12,460 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Orava hunting area is as follows:

The border of the Orava hunting area runs from the intersection of the Karisilla–Põlva road and the Kahkva–Lepassaare road along the Karisilla–Põlva road to Mäda jõgi; then along the Mäda jõgi to the Soe–Orava road and along the Soe–Orava road to the Räpina–Koidula road; from the intersection along the Räpina–Koidula road to the Piusa river and along the Piusa river to the eastern corner of block VS060 of the Võrumaa forest district; then along the southeast direction of block VS060 to the southern corner of the same block, continuing along the southwest direction of block VS060 of the Võrumaa forest district to the Obinitsa–Võru road and along the Obinitsa–Võru road to the Lindora–Lepassaare road; from the intersection along the Lindora–Lepassaare road to the Võru–Petseri railway; from there along the Võru–Petseri railway to the Obinitsa–Võru road and along the Obinitsa–Võru road to the Otsa–Lepassaare road; from the intersection along the Otsa–Lepassaare highway to the Lepassaare–Leevi highway, continuing along the Lepassaare–Leevi highway to the Lepassaare–Viluste highway and along the Lepassaare–Viluste highway to the Mudaküla highway; further along the Mudaküla highway to the Hanikase–Jantra highway, continuing along the Hanikase–Jantra highway to the Tuderna stream and along the Tuderna stream to the western border of the Lõo property; from there along the western and southern borders of the Lõo property to the Lõo road and along the Lõo road to the Lepassaare–Kahkva highway; then along the Lepassaare–Kahkva highway to the Kamnitsa–Ilumäe highway; then along the Kamnitsa–Ilumäe highway to the Rebasmäe stream, continuing along the Rebasmäe stream to the Lepassaare–Kahkva highway and along the Lepassaare–Kahkva highway to the Karisilla–Põlva highway.

§ 12. Area and boundary description of the Padise hunting area

(1) The area of the Padise hunting area is 29,460 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Padise hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Padise hunting area runs from the intersection of the Baltic Sea coastline and the Ristna–Maissoo road along the sea coastline to the mouth of the Vasalemma River (the hunting area includes a part of the marine water area that extends 200 meters

from the coastline), continuing along the Vasalemma River to the Lennuraja ditch; from there along the Lennuraja ditch to the Ämari airport road and along the Ämari airport road to Suurküla; from Suurküla along the Suurküla road to the Kasepere–Paldiski road, continuing along the Kasepere–Paldiski road to the Keila–Haapsalu road; from the road intersection along the Keila–Haapsalu road in the direction of Keila to the old Keila–Haapsalu road in the Rummu hamlet; further along the old Keila–Haapsalu road to the road marking the southern boundary of the Rummu quarry, continuing along the road to the Sõeru ditch and along the Sõeru ditch to the main ditch of the Monastery; then along the main ditch of the Monastery to the Laiassoo road and along the Laiassoo road to the Tiidu road, continuing along the Tiidu road to the Kasepere–Aude road; from the road junction along the Kasepere–Aude road to the Surnumäe direction and along the Surnumäe direction to the Kobru–Munalaskme road; from there along the Kobru–Munalaskme road to the Kloostri River, continuing along the Kloostri River to the southeast corner of the Kloostri River in the Harju County Forest District; then along the southern direction of the blocks KL169, KL164, KL163 and KL162 to the Padise–Kivitammi road; from there along the Padise–Kivitammi road to the Siimika–Lintsi forest road; from the road junction along the Siimika–Lintsi forest road to the Keila–Haapsalu road and along the Keila–Haapsalu road towards Haapsalu to the Metsavahi direction; from there along the Metsavahi direction to the Kaldamäe stream and along the Kaldamäe stream to its mouth in the Piirsalu River; then along the Piirsalu River to the Vihterpalu River and along the Vihterpalu River to the Aareni Bridge; from the Aareni Bridge along the forest road to the Soo-otsa road and along the Soo-otsa road to the Tänavjärve road, continuing along the Tänavjärve road to the Harju-Risti–Nõva road; from the road junction along the Harju-Risti–Nõva road to the Kobru–Puismaa road; further along the Kobru–Puismaa road to the Ristna–Maissoo road and along the Ristna–Maissoo road to the Baltic Sea coastline.

§ 13. Area and boundary description of Palamulla hunting area

(1) The area of the Palamulla hunting area is 11,270 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Palamulla hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Palamulla hunting area runs from the intersection of the Tallinn–Pärnu highway and the Kasari River (at the Ruunavere bridge) along the Kasari River to the Rabivere main ditch, continuing along the Rabivere main ditch to the Hageri-Kodila highway and along the Hageri-Kodila highway to the Alu-Varbola highway; from the intersection along the Alu-Varbola highway to the Ohukotsu-Nõmmealuse highway; from there along the Ohukotsu-Nõmmealuse highway to the Pärnu-Tallinn highway and along the Pärnu-Tallinn highway to the Kasari River.

§ 14. Area and boundary description of the Põrsu hunting area

§ 15. Area and boundary description of the Riguldi hunting area

(1) The area of the Riguldi hunting area is 9,290 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Riguldi hunting area is as follows:

The border of the Riguldi hunting area runs from the intersection of the Baltic Sea coastline and the Peraküla road along the Peraküla road to the Riguldi–Nõva–Harju-Rist road, continuing along the Riguldi–Nõva–Harju-Rist road to the Veski stream and along the Veski stream to the Kase route; from there along the Kase route to the Nõva River; further along the Nõva River to Tõldsilla and from Tõldsilla along the Saunamäe road to the Nõva–Haapsalu road; from the road intersection along the Nõva–Haapsalu road to the Riguldi River; then along the Riguldi River to its mouth in the Baltic Sea, continuing along the Baltic Sea coastline to the Peraküla road (the hunting area includes a part of the sea water area with islets that extends 200 meters from the coastline).

(3) The hunting area includes Osmussaar with a part of the sea area that extends 200 meters from the island's coastline.

§ 16. Area and boundary description of the Roela hunting area

(1) The area of the Roela hunting area is 13,070 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Roela hunting area is as follows:

The border of the Roela hunting area runs from the intersection of the Rakvere–Luige road and the Küti–Angus road along the Küti–Angus road to the Rakvere–Rannapungerja road, continuing along the Rakvere–Rannapungerja road to the Saunakünka–Rasivere road and along the Saunakünka–Rasivere road to the Rasivere–Kärje road; from the intersection along the Rasivere–Kärje road to the Pasti–Muuga road; then along the Pasti–Muuga road to the Rakvere–Luige road and along the Rakvere–Luige road to the southern end of the Triigi forest district block RO124; further along the southern end of the Triigi forest district blocks RO124, RO123, RO121, RO120, RO116, RO115, RO113 and RO112 to the Rahkla–Viru-Jaagupi road; then along the Rahkla–Viru-Jaagup road to the Aruküla–Kulina road, continuing along the Aruküla–Kulina road to the Rakvere–Luige road (Kulina) and along the Rakvere–Luige road to the Küti–Angus road.

The boundary of the Sooniste hunting area runs from the intersection of the Haapsalu–Ääsmäe road and the Ellamaa–Laukna road along the Ellamaa–Laukna road to the Virutamme ditch, continuing along the Virutamme ditch to the high-voltage line route and along the high-voltage line route to the Kasari River; from there along the Kasari River to the Märjamaa–Koluvere road; then along the Märjamaa–Koluvere road to the Virtsu–Rist road; from the intersection along the Virtsu–Rist road to the Haapsalu–Ääsmäe road and along the Haapsalu–Ääsmäe road to the Ellamaa–Laukna road.

The border of the Veerksu hunting area runs from the intersection of the Rāpina city border and the Rāpina–Koidula road along the Rāpina–Koidula road to Mādajõgi, continuing along the Mādajõgi to the Veerksu–Usinitsa road; further along the Veerksu–Usinitsa road to the Väike-Veerksu–Pahtpää road; from the intersection along the Väike-Veerksu–Pahtpää road to the Veerksu stream, continuing along the Veerksu stream to the Tartu–Petseri railway and along the Tartu–Petseri railway to the Põlva–Võru road and along the Põlva–Võru road to the Leesikmäe road, continuing along the Leesikmäe road to the Kirmsi–Võuküla road and along the Kirmsi–Võuküla road to the Kassilaane–Rõсна road; from there along the Kassilaane–Rõсна road to the Rõсна–Võuküla road; then along the Rõсна–Võuküla road to the Jaanikeste–Leevaku road and along the Jaanikeste–Leevaku road to the Pahtpää river; then along the Pahtpää river to the Võhandu river and along the Võhandu river to the border of the city of Rāpina, continuing along the border of the city of Rāpina to the Rāpina–Koidula road.

§ 21. Area and boundary description of the Veriora hunting area

(1) The area of the Veriora hunting area is 9,150 hectares.

The boundary of the Veriora hunting area runs from the intersection of the Veriora–Ruusa and Pindi–Pääсна roads along the Veriora–Ruusa road to the Tsiirski road, continuing along the Tsiirski road to the Leesikmäe road and along the Leesikmäe road to the Põlva–Võru road; from there along the Põlva–Võru road to the Tartu–Petseri railway; from here along the Tartu–Petseri railway to the Veerksu stream, continuing along the Veerksu stream to the Karisilla–Põlva road and along the Karisilla–Põlva road to the Põlva–Võru road; from the road intersection along the Põlva–Võru road to the Leevi–Lepassaare road, continuing along the Leevi–Lepassaare road to the Eha road and along the Eha road to the northeastern corner of the QB079 block of the Võrumaa forestry district; then along the northeastern corners of the QB079, QB076 and QB072 blocks of the Võrumaa forestry district to the northeastern corner of block QB072; thence along the northern direction of blocks QB072 and QB071 of the Võrumaa forest district to the western direction of block QB064 of the Põlvamaa forest district, continuing along the western direction of blocks QB064 and QB063 to the southern direction of block QB060 of the Põlvamaa forest district; then along the southern direction of block QB060 of the Põlvamaa forest district to the Võhandu River and along the Võhandu River to the northeastern corner of the Koolma 6 property; further along the northeastern border of the Koolma 6 property to Koolma Road and along Koolma Road to Pikkjärve Road; from the intersection along Pikkjärve Road to Koolma–Tsolgo Road, continuing along Koolma–Tsolgo Road to Timo–Leevi Road and along Timo–Leevi Road to the quarry road; then along the quarry road to Partsi–Timo Road; then along Partsi–Timo Road to Karisilla–Põlva Road and along Karisilla–Põlva Road to Uibujärve Road; then along Uibujärve road to Sillametsa farm road, continuing along Sillametsa farm road to Lepasaare ditch and along Lepasaare ditch to Ruunasoo main ditch; from there along Ruunasoo main ditch to the western border of the Tedresaare property; then along the western and southern borders of the Tedresaare property to Tedresaare farm road, continuing along Tedresaare farm road to Ruusa–Soohara road; from the intersection along Ruusa–Soohara road to the Ruusa–Põlva high-voltage line route, continuing along Ruusa–Põlva high-voltage line route to Poska main ditch; from there along Poska main ditch to Pääсна–Soohara road, continuing along Pääсна–Soohara road to Pindi–Pääсна road and along Pindi–Pääсна road to Veriora–Ruusa road.

§ 22. Area and boundary description of the Väätsa hunting area

(1) The area of the Väätsa hunting area is 10,980 hectares.

(2) The boundary description of the Väätsa hunting area is as follows:

The boundary of the Väätsa hunting area runs from the intersection of the Tallinn–Tartu road and the Ussisoo–Lintsi road along the Ussisoo–Lintsi road to the Suuresaare road, continuing along the Suuresaare road to the Reopalu river and along the Reopalu river to the Palivere road; then along the Palivere road to the Palivere point; from here along the Palivere point to the southeast corner of block VT265 of the Järvamaa forestry district; from there along the south direction of block VT265 to the Paide–Saueaugu road, continuing along the Paide–Saueaugu road to Saueaugu; from Saueaugu along the Saueaugu–Vahastu road to the west direction of block VT213 of the Järvamaa forestry district; from there along the west direction of blocks VT213, VT202 and VT188 to the northwest corner of block VT188 of the Järvamaa forestry district; then along the northern direction of blocks VT188, VT174, VT175 and VT176 to the north-west direction of block VT163 of the Järvamaa forest district; further along the north-west direction of blocks VT163, VT154, VT145 and VT143 to the north-west direction of block VT143 of the Järvamaa forest district, continuing along the northern direction of blocks VT143 and VT144 to the Saueaugu–Saarnakõrve road and along the Saueaugu–Saarnakõrve road to the Saarnakõrve–Mustla road; from the intersection along the Saarnakõrve–Mustla road to the Tallinn–Tartu road and along the Tallinn–Tartu road to the old Tallinn–Tartu road in Matsimäe; from Matsimäe along the old Tallinn–Tartu road to the new Tallinn–Tartu road in the north-west corner of block VT129 of the Järvamaa forest district, continuing along the new Tallinn–Tartu road to the Ussisoo–Lintsi road.
