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# **The procedure and rates of compensation for environmental damage caused by the destruction or damage of a protected natural object or a specimen of an unprotected animal species and the release of a specimen of a foreign species into the wild**

The regulation is established on the basis of § 77 subsection 1 of the " Nature Conservation Act ".

## **Chapter 1 ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE COMPENSATION PROCEDURE**

### **§ 1. Scope of regulation**

The regulation establishes the procedure and rates of compensation for environmental damage caused by the destruction or damage of a protected natural object or other species of birds and mammals, except game.

### **§ 2. Causing environmental damage**

(1) Causing environmental damage within the meaning of this regulation is the destruction or damage of an individual of a protected natural object or an unprotected animal species, with the exception of game, and the release into the environment of an alien species that threatens the natural balance.

(2) When using traps allowed for fishing or hunting, the death of an individual of a protected animal species in a trap is not considered to cause environmental damage.

(3) Intentional damage during national defense training is not considered to cause environmental damage within the meaning of this regulation, if the organizer of the national defense training has the permission of the Government of the Republic provided for in § 36 subsection 2 of the "Forest Act" or the permit of the private forest owner provided for in § 36 subsection 1 point 4 to use the forest for national defense training, with which they may involve forest damage.

### **§ 3. Damage to a protected area or a storage area**

Damage to a protected area or storage area is:

- 1) felling or felling of woody vegetation at a prohibited time or in a place where the type of felling used or felling is prohibited;
- 2) violation of logging conditions during logging operations;
- 3) damaging the soil without a permit or in violation of permit requirements;
- 4) burning wood or herbaceous vegetation or making a bonfire without a permit or in violation of permit requirements;
- 5) littering or pollution.

### **§ 4. Destruction and damage to permanent residence**

(1) The destruction of a permanent habitat within the meaning of this regulation is an illegal activity, as a result of which the further preservation of the species in this permanent habitat is not possible in the foreseeable future.

(2) Damage to the permanent habitat within the meaning of this regulation is an activity that is prohibited in the permanent habitat of the individual or in the protection zone of the nest according to the law or regulation (except for staying), as a result of which the species whose protection is the permanent habitat on the basis of § 10 (2) of the "Nature Protection Act" or § 50 (2) created according to, the favorable condition deteriorates, but which does not cause the permanent habitat to be destroyed.

### **§ 5. Destruction and damage to an individual object of protected nature**

(1) Destruction of an individual object of protected nature within the meaning of this regulation is its unlawful destruction, liquidation or damage to the extent that a significant part or more than 50% of the object is destroyed as a result.

(2) Damage to an individual object of protected nature within the meaning of this regulation is unlawfully changing its shape or location, spoiling its appearance, causing mechanical, chemical or other injuries.

## **§ 6. Destruction and damage to the site of a protected fossil**

(1) Destruction of a protected fossil site within the meaning of this regulation is the removal or damage of a protected fossil site without a permit or in violation of permit requirements to the extent that a significant part or more than 50% of the site is destroyed as a result.

(2) Damage to the site of a protected mineral within the meaning of this regulation is an illegal activity that causes mechanical, chemical or other damage to the site.

## **§ 7. Destruction and damage to an individual of a protected species**

(1) Destruction of an individual of a protected animal species within the meaning of this regulation is the unlawful killing of an individual, injury to the point of incapacitation (including pollution), removal from nature, alienation of an animal or its part.

(2) Damage to an individual of a protected animal species within the meaning of this regulation is unlawful disturbance or injury to an individual (including pollution), which reduces the individual's ability to live, but does not prevent its reproduction.

(3) The destruction of an individual of a non-protected bird and mammal species, with the exception of game, within the meaning of this regulation, is the unlawful killing of an individual, injury to the point of incapacitation (including pollution) or removal from the wild.

(4) Destruction of a specimen of a protected plant, moss, mushroom and lichen species within the meaning of this regulation is unlawful rendering of the specimen incapable of growth, removal from the place of growth, alienation of the specimen or its part.

(5) In the sense of this regulation, damage to an individual of a protected plant, moss, mushroom and lichen species is partial removal of the individual from the place of growth.

(6) EU Council Regulation No. 338/97 on the protection of wild animal and plant species by regulating their trade (OJ L 061, 3.03.1997, p. 1) in Annexes A–D is considered to be a violation of the said regulation and the rules established on its basis as damage to the specimens of the species .

## **§ 8. Form of act for determining the amount of environmental damage**

Upon detection of environmental damage, the supervisory authority prepares an act of determining the amount of environmental damage according to the form provided in the annex to the regulation.

## **§ 9. Peculiarities in the calculation of environmental damage compensation rates**

(1) For the destruction or damage of an individual of a protected animal species or a permanent habitat or an individual of another bird or mammal species during the gestation, lactation or nesting period, the amount of environmental damage established by this regulation for each specific species shall be applied to the extent of three times.

(2) In case of damage to the egg-strainer or nest with eggs of a protected bird species, or if eggs are collected without a permit or in violation of permit requirements, half of the rate of environmental damage per egg established by regulation for the individual of the corresponding bird species shall be applied to compensate for the damage; if it is not possible to determine the number of eggs, then in three times per nest.

(3) In case of destruction of nests of eagles and black storks of protection category I without eggs or nestlings, half of the rate of environmental damage established by the regulation shall be applied per nest.

(4) The parts of the plant, which according to the quantity may belong to one specimen, are considered as one specimen. The trunk and branches of the tree are not considered part of the plant.

(5) In case of the destruction or damage of a specimen of a protected species accompanying the destruction or damage of a permanent place, protected area or storage area, the compensation rates shall be added.

(6) If the destruction or damage of an individual of a protected species is accompanied by a violation of EU Council Regulation No. 338/97 and the rules established on the basis thereof, the compensation rates are added.

## **§ 10. Measurement of a tree in the calculation of environmental damage**

The diameter of the tree trunk is measured together with the bark at a height of 10 centimeters from the root collar, perpendicular to the long axis of the trunk. If the root neck of the tree is below the ground, the diameter of the trunk is measured 10 cm above the ground.

# **Chapter 2 RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE**

## **§ 11. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of a specimen of a plant species of protection category I and permanent habitat**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of a specimen of a plant species of protection category I is 130 euros per specimen, and for damage it is 32 euros per specimen.

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(2) The rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the permanent habitat of a plant species of protection category I is:

1) 260 euros for each square meter of permanent habitat destroyed, but no more than 9,600 euros per permanent habitat;

2) 130 euros in case of damage to each square meter of permanent habitat, but no more than 3,200 euros per permanent habitat.

**§ 12. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of a specimen of mushroom, lichen and lichen species and permanent habitat of protection category I**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of mushroom, lichen and moss species of protection category I:

- 1) is 96 euros per specimen;
- 2) damage is 16 euros per specimen.

(2) The rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the permanent habitat of mushroom, lichen and moss species of protection category I:

1) for the destruction of each square meter of the permanent habitat is 260 euros, but not more than 9,600 euros per permanent habitat;

2) in case of damage to each square meter of permanent habitat, it is 130 euros, but not more than 3,200 euros per permanent habitat.

**§ 13. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species and permanent habitat of protection category II**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of one- and two-year-old herbaceous species of protection category II:

- 1) is 64 euros per specimen;
- 2) damage is 6.40 euros per specimen.

(2) Rate of compensation for one meter stem part of a fern, perennial herbaceous specimen, sedge, bush, tree or ivy up to one meter high of protection category II:

- 1) for destruction is 130 euros per specimen;
- 2) damage is 32 euros per specimen.

(3) The rate of compensation for the destruction of specimens of moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category II:

- 1) for fresh lichen, moss and mushroom or their parts is 3.20 euros per gram;
- 2) for dried lichen, moss and mushroom or their parts is 6.40 euros per gram.

(4) The rate of compensation for damage to specimens of moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category II:

- 1) for fresh moss, lichen and mushroom or their parts is 1.30 euros per gram;
- 2) for dried moss, lichen and mushroom or their parts is 3.20 euros per gram.

(5) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category II with a trunk diameter of up to 10 centimeters:

- 1) 64 euros per tree for destruction;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 13 euros per tree.

(6) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category II with a trunk diameter of 10–30 centimeters:

- 1) for destruction is 130 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 20 euros per tree.

(7) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category II with a trunk diameter of more than 30 centimeters:

- 1) for destruction is 320 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 64 euros per tree.

(8) The rate of compensation for damage or destruction of the permanent habitat of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category II:

- 1) for each square meter of permanent habitat destroyed is 130 euros, but not more than 9,600 euros for one permanent habitat;
- 2) in case of damage to each square meter of permanent habitat, it is 32 euros, but not more than 3,200 euros per permanent habitat.

**§ 14. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species and permanent habitat of protection category III**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category III:

- 1) in the case of fresh plant, moss, lichen and fungus or their parts is 1.60 euros per gram;
- 2) in case of dried plant, lichen and mushroom or their parts, it is 3.20 euros per gram.

(2) The rate of compensation for damage to a specimen of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category III:

- 1) in the case of fresh plant, moss, lichen and fungus or their parts is 0.64 euros per gram;
- 2) in the case of dried plant, moss, lichen and mushroom or their parts, it is 1.60 euros per gram.

(3) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category III up to one meter in height:

- 1) for destruction is 32 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 6.40 euros per tree.

(4) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category III with a height of over one meter and a trunk diameter of up to 10 centimeters:

- 1) for destruction is 45 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 9.60 euros per tree.

(5) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category III with a trunk diameter of 10–30 centimeters:

- 1) for destruction is 64 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 13 euros per tree.

(6) The rate of compensation for a tree of protection category III with a trunk diameter of more than 30 centimeters:

- 1) for destruction is 200 euros per tree;
- 2) for damage to the extent that it reduces the vitality of the tree, it is 32 euros per tree.

(7) The rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of permanent habitat of plant, moss, lichen and mushroom species of protection category III:

- 1) in case of destruction of each square meter of permanent habitat is 64 euros, but for one permanent habitat no more than 9,600 euros;
- 2) in case of damage to each square meter of permanent habitat, it is 13 euros, but not more than 3,200 euros per permanent habitat.

#### **§ 15. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of an animal species of protection category I**

(1) The rate of compensation for damage to a specimen of a vertebrate species of protection category I is 200 euros per specimen.

(2) The rate of compensation for the destruction of an animal species of protection category I:

- 1) in the case of an amphibian species is 640 euros per individual;
- 2) in the case of an individual of a bird species or a mammal species, it is 1300 euros per individual.

(3) The rate of compensation in case of destruction or damage of an invertebrate animal species of protection category I is 320 euros per specimen.

#### **§ 16. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of an animal species of protection category II**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of an animal species of protection category II:

- 1) in the case of an invertebrate animal species is 64 euros per individual;
- 2) in the case of a specimen of a fish, amphibian, reptile or winged species, it is 320 euros per specimen;
- 3) in the case of an individual of a bird species, it is 640 euros per individual;
- 4) in the case of a specimen of a mammal species, it is 960 euros per specimen.

(2) The rate of compensation for damage to an individual of a vertebrate species of protection category II is 64 euros per individual.

#### **§ 17. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of an animal species of protection category III**

(1) The rate of compensation for the destruction of a specimen of an animal species of protection category III:

1) in the case of a specimen of an invertebrate animal species (with the exception of snails, snails and bumblebees) is 32 euros per specimen;

- 2) in the case of a specimen of a fish species, it is 64 euros per specimen;
- 3) in the case of a specimen of a reptile or amphibian species, it is 32 euros per specimen;
- 4) in the case of an individual of a bird species, it is 320 euros per individual;
- 5) in the case of an individual of a box-striped, nutty or licorice, it is 320 euros per individual;
- 6) in the case of a porpoise, wolverine or otter specimen, it is 640 euros per specimen.

(2) The rate of compensation for damage to a specimen of a vertebrate species of protection category III is 32 euros per specimen.

#### **§ 18. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category I**

The rate of compensation for the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category I:

- 1) for destruction is 9,600 euros per permanent habitat;
- 2) for damage is 3200 euros per permanent residence.

#### **§ 19. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category II**

The rate of compensation for the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category II:

- 1) for destruction is 3200 euros per permanent habitat;
- 2) for damage is 1600 euros per permanent residence.

## **§ 20. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category III**

The rate of compensation for the permanent habitat of an animal species of protection category III:

- 1) for destruction is 1600 euros per permanent habitat;
- 2) damage is 640 euros per permanent residence.

## **§ 21. The rate of compensation for the destruction of the nest of the species III of protection category**

The rate of compensation for the destruction of a nest of a species of protection category III:

- 1) is 320 euros per nest, if the diameter of the bottom of the nest at its widest point on the ground is one meter or more;
- 2) is 130 euros per nest, if the diameter of the bottom of the nest at the widest point on the ground is less than one meter.

## **§ 22. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of an individual object of protected nature**

(1) The rate of compensation for individual object of protected nature:

- 1) destruction is 1600 euros per individual object;
- 2) damage is 320 euros per individual object.

(2) The rate of compensation for a tree designated as an individual object of nature to be protected:

- 1) for destruction is 2,000 euros per tree designated as an individual object;
- 2) damage is 640 euros per tree designated as an individual object.

## **§ 23. Rate of compensation for damage to the protected area**

(1) Within the protected area, the damage caused to the environment during the felling or clearing of woody vegetation is taken into account on the basis of § 67 of the "Forest Act".

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(2) In case of illegal damage to the soil in semi-natural and swamp communities located outside outdoor land within the protected area, the compensation rate is 1.60 euros per square meter in the restricted zone and 2.30 euros per square meter in the target protection zone.

(3) In case of illegal fire of semi-natural and marsh communities located outside the outdoor area within the protected area, the compensation rate is 0.96 euros per square meter in the restricted zone and 1.60 euros per square meter in the target protection zone.

(4) In the case of illegal littering of semi-natural and swamp communities located outside outdoor land within the protected area, the compensation rate is 1.60 euros per square meter in the restricted zone and 2.30 euros per square meter in the target protection zone.

## **§ 24. Rate of compensation for damage to the storage area**

(1) Within the conservation area, damage caused to the environment during the felling or clearing of woody vegetation is taken into account on the basis of § 67 of the "Forest Act".

(2) In the case of illegal damage to the soil in semi-natural communities located outside the outdoor area within the conservation area, the compensation rate is 1.60 euros per square meter.

(3) In the case of causing an illegal fire of semi-natural communities located outside the outdoor area within the conservation area, the compensation rate is 0.96 euros per square meter.

## **§ 25. Rate of compensation for the destruction of non-protected species of birds and mammals, with the exception of game**

The rate of compensation for the destruction of an individual of a non-protected bird and mammal species, with the exception of hunting game:

1) in the case of the ptarmigan, merisk, kurvits, tyllas, ruffed grosbeak, stilt, pigeon, cuckoo, shrike, woodpecker, and species of the colored group is 32 euros per specimen about;

2) in the case of individuals of the hedgehog species, voles, weasels and mute swans, it is 64 euros per individual;

3) in the case of an individual of a non-protected bird species not mentioned in point 1, it is 6.40 euros per individual.

#### **§ 26. Rate of compensation for the destruction or damage of the fossil site**

(1) The rate of compensation for the fossil site of protection category I:

- 1) for the destruction of each square meter is 640 euros, but not more than 9,600 euros in total for one site;
- 2) 320 euros for each square meter of damage, but no more than 3200 euros for one site.

(2) The rate of compensation for the fossil site of protection category II:

- 1) for the destruction of each square meter is 320 euros, but not more than 9,600 euros in total for one site;
- 2) 160 euros for each square meter of damage, but no more than 3,200 euros in total for one site.

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#### **§ 26 . The rate of compensation for releasing, planting and sowing a specimen of an alien species that threatens the natural balance**

(1) The rate of compensation for planting or sowing a specimen of a plant species threatening the natural balance in the wild is 13 euros per specimen.

(2) The rate of compensation for releasing an animal species that threatens the natural balance into the wild is 320 euros per individual.

#### **§ 27. Rate of compensation for violation of the rules of transactions and operations with specimens of animal species specified in Annexes A-D of EU Council Regulation No. 338/97**

(1) The rate of compensation for violation of the rules of transactions and operations with specimens of the class of mammals not mentioned in subsections 2-11 is:

- 1) in the case of a living specimen, 200 euros per specimen;
- 2) 640 euros per individual in the case of a live specimen of the species specified in Appendix A from nature;
- 3) 320 euros per individual in the case of a living specimen of the species mentioned in other appendices from nature;
- 4) in the case of a product made from a specimen, 200 euros per product.

(2) The rate of compensation for violation of the rules of transactions and operations with specimens of primates, i.e. primates, is:

- 1) in the case of a living specimen, 320 euros per specimen;
- 2) 20,000 euros per specimen in the case of a live specimen from nature specified in Appendix A;
- 3) 3,200 euros per specimen in the case of a live specimen of the species mentioned in other appendices from nature;
- 4) in the case of a product made from a specimen of the species specified in Annex A, 640 euros per product;
- 5) 320 euros per product in the case of a product made from a specimen of the species specified in other appendices;
- 6) in the case of meat or a product intended for food, 200 euros per kilogram.

(3) The rate of compensation for the violation of the rules of transactions and operations with a specimen of a species of the superior ape family is:

- 1) in the case of a living specimen, 640 euros per specimen;
- 2) in the case of a live specimen from nature, 64,000 euros per specimen;
- 3) in the case of a product made from a specimen, 6,400 euros per product;
- 4) in the case of meat or a product intended for food, 640 euros per kilogram.

(4) The rate of compensation for violation of the rules of transactions and operations with a cetacean society is:

- 1) in the case of a product, 32 euros per product;
- 2) 64 euros per kilogram for meat and fat.

- 1) in the case of a live specimen, 200 euros per specimen;

- 4) in the case of a skull, 32 euros per skull;
- 5) in the case of a product made from one or more whole animals, 200 euros per product;
- 6) in the case of a product made from less than one animal, 64 euros per product.

(6) The rate of compensation for the violation of the rules of transactions and operations with a specimen of a bear family species is:
