

List of Documents Certifying the Recovery of Packaging

Regulation No. 10 of 11 February 1997 of the Minister of the Environment

Pursuant to subsection 2 of section 9 of the Packaging Excise Duty Act (RT (State Gazette) I 1997, 5/6, 31), I hereby establish:

1. to approve the list of documents certifying the recovery of packaging (attached);
2. this Regulation shall come into effect on 1 March 1997.

List of Documents Certifying the Recovery of Packaging

Regulation No. 10 of 11 February 1997 of the Minister of the Environment

In applying for the packaging recovery certificate, the following documents shall be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment:

1. an application for the recovery certificate for a fixed time period (not exceeding one year) together with the information on organisation of the recovery of packaging planned by the enterprise;
2. information on the entrepreneur applying for the exemption from excise duty:

- name of the entrepreneur;

- business registration code/business registration number;

- account number;
- address;
- main field of activity (and the relevant classification code of economic activity)
- director of the enterprise (name, telephone and fax number);
- contact person (name, telephone and fax number, e-mail);
- packaging-related activity (packaging and/or import);
- packaging and/or import of goods (by the entrepreneur) the packaging of which shall be liable to the packaging excise duty;

1. the certificate of packaging volumes by packaging materials and containment capacity of packaging units, expressed in thous. pieces and tonnes, planned to be imported and/or filled during the term of validity of the recovery certificate applied for, and of packaging volumes by packaging material and containment capacity of packaging units, expressed in thous. pieces and tonnes, imported and/or filled during the calendar year preceding the year for which the recovery certificate is applied;
2. the certificate of packaging volumes (in tonnes) planned to be recovered or the recovery of which shall be arranged by the entrepreneur in the term of validity of the recovery

certificate applied for (by packaging material and methods of recovery), and of packaging volumes (in tonnes) recovered or the recovery of which has been arranged by the entrepreneur in the calendar year preceding the year for which the recovery certificate is applied (by packaging material and methods of recovery);

3. confirmation (letter of commitment) of recovery of packaging by the entrepreneur (in his/her enterprise) during the term of validity of the recovery certificate;
4. valid agreements concluded with other enterprises involved in the recovery of packaging, e. g. enterprises treating or exporting packaging waste, who ensure the recovery of packaging during the term of validity of the recovery certificate applied for at least in the scope set out in clause 1 of section 8 of the Packaging Excise Duty Act;
5. valid agreements concluded with the enterprises organising the collection of used packaging and/or packaging waste, who ensure the delivery of packaging and/or packaging waste to the enterprise involved in the packaging recovery.
