## OMBUDSMAN (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015.

2. The Ombudsman Act Cap. 218B is amended by Amendment of repealing section 5 and substituting the following therefor—

section 5 of principal Act. "Tenure of office.

- 5.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this section, a person appointed as Ombudsman shall hold office for a period not exceeding five years and shall, at the expiration of such period, be eligible for reappointment.
- (2) A person appointed as Ombudsman pursuant to subsection (1) may on his or her own request be relieved of his or her office by the Governor-General and shall in any case, subject to subsection (3), vacate office on attaining the age of seventy years.
- (3) Notwithstanding that the Ombudsman has attained the age required by or under the provisions of this section to vacate his or her office, the Ombudsman may continue in office for a period, which shall not exceed one year after attaining the age of seventy as the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Prime Minister and the Leader of the Opposition may specify in order to enable the Ombudsman to give his or her decision or do any other thing in relation to any investigation he or she was conducting before he or she attained that age.
- (4) Nothing done by the Ombudsman shall be invalid by reason only that he or she has attained the age at which he or she is required by this section to vacate office."
