

PEOPLE'S LAW NO. 33 OF 1981

PR O C L A M A T I O N

BY THE

PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT

A LAW to amend the Land Development and Utilization Law, 1981.

[ *Gazetted 28th September, 1981* ].

In the exercise of the powers vested in the People's Revolutionary Government by People's Law No. 2 (Establishment of People's Revolutionary Government) and in exercise of the powers vested in the Prime Minister by People's Law No. 10 (Declaration and Effect of Laws) it is hereby ORDERED and PROCLAIMED as follows:

1.— This Law may be cited as the

LAND DEVELOPMENT AND UTILIZATION  
(AMENDMENT) LAW, 1981,

and shall be read as one with the Land Development and Utilization Law, 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law).

2.— Section 2 of the principal Law is amended :

(a) in the definition of "prescribed acreage" in subsection (1) by repealing the number "26" and substituting the number "21".

(b) in subsection (3) by repealing the word "to" where it first appears in the subsection and substituting the word "in".

3.— Subsection (5) of section 8 of the Principal Law is amended by repealing the word “in” where it appears after the words “shall be let to” and before the words “the Crown”.

4.— Section 12 of the principal law is amended by repealing the words “in the interest of the Island, and the Commission shall give effect thereto” and substituting the words “in the public interest, and the Commission shall give effect thereto”.

5.— Section 18 of the principal Law is amended by repealing the words “having an interest in, agricultural land of any size whatsoever” and substituting the words “having an interest in, any land comprising or included in an agricultural unit”.

6.— The Schedule of the principal Law is amended by repealing the words “thirty-first day of September” in subparagraph (2) of paragraph 14 and substituting the words “thirtieth day of September.”
