## **ANIMALS (DISEASES AND IMPORTATION) (POULTRY) REGULATIONS**

[19th September, 1953.]

### 1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Diseases and Importation) (Poultry) Regulations.

### 2. Definitions

In these Regulations—

“carcass” means the carcass of any fowl, turkey, duck or goose;

“fully cooked” when used in connection with a carcass or part of a carcass means cooked throughout the whole of its substance so as to render it unnecessary for it to be further cooked before being used for human consumption;

“hatching eggs” means the eggs of poultry intended for hatching;

“poultry” means live fowls, turkeys, ducks or geese.

### 3. Prohibition

No person shall import or bring into the State any poultry, or the carcass or the viscera or hatching eggs thereof:

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to—

(a)

a carcass or part of a carcass which has been fully cooked or is for human consumption;

(b)

poultry or a carcass or part of a carcass or hatching eggs brought from any country specified in Part I of the First Schedule hereto;

(c)

poultry or a carcass or part of a carcass or hatching eggs brought from any country specified in Part II of the First Schedule hereto where such poultry carcass or hatching eggs are accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the Second Schedule hereto and signed by a duly authorised officer of the Government in the country from which the importation was made.
