PROCLAMATION
BY THE
PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT
A LAW to amend the Water Supply Act, 1969.

[25th May, 1979].

In the exercise of the powers vested in the People's Revolutionary Government by People's Law No. 2 (Establishment of People's Revolutionary Government) and in exercise of the powers vested in the Prime Minister by People's Law No. 10 (Declaration and Effect of Laws) it is hereby ORDERED and PROCLAIMED as follows :

1. This Law may be cited as the
WATER SUPPLY (AMENDMENT) LAW, 1979,

and shall be read as one with the Water Supply Act, 1969, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) as amended.

2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following paragraph substituted :—

“(c) a senior officer in the Ministry of Health;”.

3. The principal Act is amended by repealing the word “Governor” wherever it occurs and substituting the word “Minister”.
