

PEOPLE'S LAW NO. 3 OF 1982

PROCLAMATION

BY THE

PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT

A LAW to amend the Water Supply Act 1969.

[*Gazetted 29th January, 1982*].

In the exercise of the powers vested in the People's Revolutionary Government by People's Law No. 2 (Establishment of People's Revolutionary Government) and in exercise of the powers vested in the Prime Minister by People's Law No. 10 (Declaration and Effect of Laws) it is hereby ORDERED and PROCLAIMED as follows :

1.— This Law may be cited as the

Short title.

WATER SUPPLY (AMENDMENT) LAW 1982.

2.— The Water Supply Act 1969 (as amended) is amended in section 19 by inserting the following subsection after subsection (3) :—

Act 23 of 1970 amended in section 19.

“(4) Notwithstanding section 21 of this Law where the assessed annual rental of a tenement does not exceed \$120.00 the minimum annual charge shall be —

(a) \$24.00 if there is no private water connection, or;

(b) \$42.00 if there is a private water connection.”.

3.— The Water Supply Amendment Law 1981 is amended in the long title and the short title by deleting the figures “1960” and in each case substituting the figures “1969”.
