

PEOPLE'S LAW NO. 88 OF 1979

PROCLAMATION

BY THE

PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT

A LAW to amend the Pesticides Control Act, 1973.

[*Gazetted 16th November, 1979*].

In the exercise of the powers vested in the People's Revolutionary Government by People's Law No. 2 (Establishment of People's Revolutionary Government) and in exercise of the powers vested in the Prime Minister by People's Law No. 10 (Declaration and Effect of Laws) it is hereby ORDERED and PROCLAIMED as follows:

1. This Law may be cited as the

Short title.

PESTICIDES CONTROL (AMENDMENT) LAW,
1979,

and shall be read as one with the Pesticides Control Act, 1973, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. No. 28 of
1973.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended: *g*

(a) by repealing the definitions of "agriculture" and "extermination" and substituting the following definitions—

“agriculture” means the production and storage of any produce and includes the use of land for grazing, forestry and woodland, fish culture, bee culture, market gardening, horticulture and nurseries or animal husbandry;

pesticides for the destruction or control
 "extermination" means the use of pesti-
 of pests on any land or premises
 or in a vehicle, ship or aircraft
 whether on land or any other
 place;"

(b) in the definition of "pest"—

- (i) by repealing the word "Microorganism"
 and substituting the word "microor-
 ganism;"
- (ii) by inserting after "or ectoparasites" the
 words "and endo parasites."

3. After section 4 of the principal Act, the following
 section is inserted:

"Appointment
 of Secretary
 and other
 officers and
 servants.

4A. The Board may, with the approval of
 the Minister, appoint at such remuneration
 and on such terms as it may determine a
 Secretary and such other officers and ser-
 vants as may be necessary for the proper
 performance of its functions."

4. Subsection (5) of section 8 of the principal Act is
 amended by repealing the word "reply" and substituting
 the word "rely."
