## **The Animal Carcasses (Control of Burial) Ordinance, 1998**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of 29<sup>th</sup> April 1998<sup>a</sup> and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2 of the Prevention of Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 1989<sup>b</sup>, hereby order: –

### **Prohibition of burial of certain animal carcasses on private land.**

1. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, a person shall not dispose of the carcass of any deceased bovine or equine animal by burying it, otherwise than on such public land and in accordance with such conditions as may be approved by the States [Home Department].

(2) A person does not contravene this section by complying with, and is not excused by this section from any obligation to comply with, an order made by the States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board under section 5(a) of the Animal Health Ordinance, 1996<sup>b</sup>.
