

The Water Restrictions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1997

WHEREAS the States Water Board on 5th June, 1997 made the Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

NOW THEREFORE THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Committee by Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a and pursuant to the powers now vested in the States by Article 30 of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Fourniture d'Eau par les États de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on 7th May, 1927^b, hereby orders:-

Byelaws sanctioned

1. The Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby sanctioned.

Citation

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Water Restrictions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1997.

SCHEDULE

Section 1

Byelaws made by the States Water Board under Article 30 of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les États de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on 7th May, 1927

1. For paragraph 1(c) of the Water (Restrictions) Byelaws, 1976^c there is substituted:

"(c) for the purposes of filling or replenishing -

- (i) any swimming pool situated within the curtilage of a dwelling house,
- (ii) any swimming pool associated with a bona fide educational establishment,
- (iii) the swimming pools situated at the Beau Séjour Centre,
- (iv) any swimming pool situated in a commercial health or leisure centre, or in other commercial premises,

- (v) any swimming pool situated within the curtilage of, or otherwise associated with, premises covered by a boarding permit,
- (vi) any non-domestic swimming pool used wholly or mainly for therapeutic purposes,
- (vii) any other non-domestic swimming pool administered by a public, community or charitable organisation."

2. These Byelaws may be cited as the Water Restrictions (Amendment) Byelaws, 1997.
