THE IMPORT OF PIGEONS ORDER, 2001

Made	10 April 2001
Laid before the States	2001
Coming into force	11 April 2001

The States Agriculture and Countryside Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 3(ii) of the Poultry Importation Ordinance, 1950, as amended (a), hereby orders: *Lwel*

1. The importation of pigeons into the Islands is prohibited other than under the authority of a licence issued by the Board.
2. In this Order the following meaning shall apply:
"Island" means the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.
3. The Import of Pigeons Order, 1984 (b) is hereby repealed.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as the Import of Pigeons Order, 2001
6. This Order shall come into force on 11 April 2001.
