The Animal Products Importation (Amendment) Order, 1991

Made 16th April 1991.

Laid before the States 1991.

Coming into operation 17th April 1991.

THE STATES AGRICULTURAL AND MILK MARKETING BOARD,
in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the
Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export)
Ordinance, 1952, as amended(a) and now vested in the
Board(b), hereby orders:-

1. In Article 2 of the Animal Products
Importation Order, 1985(c) between "Botswana" and
"Swaziland" there is inserted "Namibia".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(d)
applies to the interpretation of this Order as it

3. This Order may be cited as the Animal Products Importation (Amendment) Order, 1991.

4. This Order and the Animal Products Importation Order, 1985 may be cited together as the Animal Products Importation Orders, 1985 and 1991.

5. This order shall come into force on 17th April 1991.

This Order adds Namibia to the list of countries from which it is permitted to import, via the U.K. or the Republic of Ireland, boneless beef excluding offal.
