

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)

(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 1991


THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law 1946, hereby orders:-

1. In Schedule 1 to The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1990 (a), entry 6 shall be deleted and the following entry substituted in its place.

"6. Live animals other than budgerigars, canaries, cats, dogs (not being the type of dog commonly known as the Pit Bull Terrier, the type of dog commonly known as the Japanese Tosa (or Tosa) or any other type of dog which appears to have been bred for fighting), donkeys, fish, goats, guinea pigs, hamsters, horses, pigs, poultry (meaning in this paragraph domestic fowls, ducks, geese, guinea fowls and turkeys), rabbits, pigeons and sheep."

2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1991, and shall come into force this 22nd May 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit the importation from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man, of the type of dog commonly known as Pit Bull Terrier, the type of dog commonly known as the Japanese Tosa (or Tosa) and any other type of dog which appears to have been bred for fighting.
