The Ornithogalum (Control of Importation) Order, 1982

Made . 17th December, 1982
Laid before the States
Coming into Operation . 1st January, 1983

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section thirteen of the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinance, 1982 (a), hereby orders:-

1. The landing in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou of bulbs of the plant Ornithogalum (commonly known as Chinchinchees) is hereby prohibited unless there shall have been issued by the Committee to the importer thereof a licence in that behalf.
2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the expression "the Committee" means the States Committee for Horticulture and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinance, 1982.

(2) Any reference in this Order to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Order.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Ornithogalum (Control of Importation) Order, 1982.
5. This Order shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The purpose of this Order is to introduce a licencing system for the importation into this Island of bulbs of the plant *Ornithogalum* (commonly known as Chinchinchees) as part of control measures to prevent the non-indigenous disease known as Crown Rot (*Corticium rolfsii*).
