

**The Sea Fish Licensing (Licence Fees)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 2012**

THE STATES COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 5 of the Sea Fish Licensing (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003^a and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

Citation and commencement.

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fish Licensing (Licences Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2012 and shall come into force on the 1st November, 2012.

(2) Expressions set out in these regulations have the same meaning as in the Sea Fish Licensing (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these regulations throughout the Bailiwick.

(4) Any reference in these regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Licence fee.

2. The charge for the purposes of section 5(2) of the Sea Fish Licensing (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003 is £500 (but no charge is payable where the licence applied for authorises fishing for sea fish only within the territorial seas adjacent to Guernsey, Alderney and/or Sark).

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the regulations)

These regulations prescribe, for the purposes of section 5 of the Sea Fish Licensing (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, the fee payable in Guernsey in respect of a licence authorising fishing for sea fish within Bailiwick fishery limits. The fee is not payable where the licence applied for authorises fishing only within the territorial seas adjacent to Guernsey, Alderney and/or Sark.
