**The Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey)
(Prescribed Forms) Regulations, 2012**

THE TREASURY AND RESOURCES DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 8 and 12A of, and paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to, the Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) Law, 1949^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Prescribed forms.

1. The form of the various documents referred to, and required by, the Law are prescribed by these Regulations.

Draft orders.

2. (1) The form of a draft compulsory purchase order referred to in paragraph 1(1)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 1 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) The form of a draft temporary possession order referred to in

paragraph 1(1)(b) of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 2 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(3) The form of a draft control of use order referred to in paragraph 1(1)(c) of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 3 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(4) The form of a draft variation order referred to in paragraph 1(1)(d) of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 4 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Notices.

3. (1) The form of a notice to qualifying persons referred to in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 5 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) The form of a notice referred to in paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 to the Law shall be Form 6 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(3) The form of a notice referred to in section 8 of the Law shall be Form 7 as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

4. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

"**the Law**" means the Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) Law, 1949,

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect,

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

(2) The notes set out in relation to each of the Forms in the Schedule are only for the purposes of general guidance and are without prejudice to any provision of the Law or these Regulations, or any practice or procedures adopted by the Treasury and Resources Department.


(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(4) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) (Prescribed Forms) Regulations, 2011 and shall come into force on the 3rd July 2012.

FORM 1

FORM OF DRAFT COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER

The Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) Law, 1949, as amended ("the Law")

2. The Department therefore declares the Land to be vested in the States of Guernsey under Section 1 of the Law, and the [(b)] (referred to in section 10 of the Law as the "**Acquiring Department**") shall acquire the Land for and on behalf of the States of Guernsey.
3. The Statement of Reasons (as defined under paragraph 1(2)(b)(i) of Schedule 2 to the Law) is as follows –

The Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) Law, 1949, as amended ("the Law")

The [(b)] submits the following Draft Temporary Possession Order to the [(c)] pursuant to paragraph 1(1)(b) of Schedule 2 to the Law.

1. The [(c)] (the "**Department**") is satisfied that it is expedient for the carrying out of a public purpose (as set out in paragraph 3 of this Order) that the States of Guernsey should temporarily take possession of the land described in paragraph 4 of this Order (the "**Land**").
2. The Department therefore declares, under section 4 of the Law, that the [(b)] (referred to in section 10 of the Law as the "**Acquiring Department**") shall, for and on behalf of the States of Guernsey, temporarily take possession of the Land. It shall therefore be lawful for the Acquiring Department, for and on behalf of the States of Guernsey, and for any person authorised by them, to enter and take possession of the Land to the exclusion of any other persons for the period [[(d)] and to make such alterations and generally do such things on the Land as may be requisite for the carrying out of the public purpose.
3. The Statement of Reasons (as defined under paragraph 1(2)(b)(ii) of Schedule 2 to the Law) is as follows –

- (d) *Insert the date of the Order.*
- (e) *Delete as appropriate.*
- (f) *Insert the name of the acquiring department.*
- (g) *Insert one of the following - "acquiring", "temporarily taking possession of", "having control of", "having control of the access to or over", "having control of both the use of and the right of access to or over" or "varying an existing [temporary possession] [control of use] order in relation to".*
- (h) *Describe the purpose for which the land is required in precise terms. i.e. insert the purposes as stated in the Order (i.e. the Statement of Reasons).*
- (i) *Insert details of location.*
- (j) *Insert the name of the position and the Department to whom the notice should be addressed.*
- (k) *Insert a date 21 days from the date of service of the notice. This date should be in bold font.*
- (l) *Insert one of the following "acquisition", "temporary possession", "control the use of", "control the access to", or "control the use of and access to".*

- (m) *Describe the extent, description and situation of the land in such a way as to enable the reader to appreciate exactly what is included.*
 - (n) *Insert date.*
 - (o) *Delete as appropriate.*

These Regulations prescribe the form of various documents required under the Compulsory Acquisition of Land (Guernsey) Law, 1949, as amended.
