The Bovine Semen (Importation) Order, 2015

Made 19th March 2015
Coming into operation 1st April 2015
Laid before the States 2015

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2A(1) of the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957^a and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Bovine Breeds from which Semen can be Imported.

1. The bovine breeds from which the Department can import, or cause the importation of, semen (from Great Britain) are as follows -

Aberdeen Angus
Belgian Blue
Black Limousin
Black Highland
Blonde d'Aquitaine
Charollais
Guernsey
Hereford
Main Anjou
Murray Grey
Simmental
Wagyu.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise -

"enactment" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

and

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) In this Order, a reference to any enactment is a reference to the enactment as from time to time amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(3) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b apply to the interpretation of this Order as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

Revocation.

3. The Bovine Semen (Importation) Order, 2013^c is revoked.

Citation and commencement.

4. This Order may be cited as the Bovine Semen (Importation) Order, 2015 and shall come into force on the 1st April, 2015.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order specifies the bovine breeds from which the Commerce and Employment Department can import, or cause the importation of, semen for the artificial insemination of cattle on the Island. Under section 2A(1) of the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, such semen can be imported from Great Britain.

This Order also revokes the Bovine Semen (Importation) Order, 2013, which listed the previous bovine breeds from which the Department could import, or cause the importation of, semen.

This Order comes into force on the 1st April, 2015.
