

The Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2015

<i>Made</i>	<i>28th September, 2015</i>

THE PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Loi ayant rapport a la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile, 1927, as amended^a, sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

Increase in water charges for 2016.

1. For paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Schedule to the Water Charges Ordinance 1991^c, as amended, substitute the following paragraphs –

"1. The charges which may be made under section 5 for a supply of water to a property by measure are –

- (a) a charge of £1.94 per cubic metre of water supplied, and

- (b) the quarterly charge in column 2 below appearing opposite the size shown in column 1 of the meter which measures the property's supply.

1. Size of meter	2. Quarterly charge
15 mm (½")	£27.82
20 mm (¾")	£41.49
25 mm (1")	£45.96
40 mm (1½")	£51.72
50 mm (2")	£54.71
75 mm (3")	£57.49
100 mm (4")	£63.21

2. The charge which may be made under section 4 or 6 for a supply of water for domestic purposes to a property otherwise than by measure is the quarterly charge in column 2 below and a quarterly charge of £0.52 multiplied by each assessable unit of the property as calculated for the purposes of property tax under the provisions of the Taxation of Real Property (Guernsey and Alderney) Ordinance, 2007^d.

1. Rate per assessable unit of TRP	2. Quarterly charge
£0.52	£27.82

Revocation.

2. The Water Charges (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2014^e are revoked.

Interpretation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2015.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st January, 2016.
