**The Animal Welfare  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2017**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10(3) and 79 of the Animal Welfare (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment of the Animal Welfare (Requirements for Slaughter, Killing, Euthanasia Etc.) Order, 2014.**

1. In Part II of Schedule 1 to the Animal Welfare (Requirements for Slaughter, Killing, Euthanasia Etc.) Order, 2014<sup>b</sup> -

- (a) in paragraph 5(1), immediately after the words "French partridge", add the words ", Eurasian woodcock", and

- (b) in paragraph 5(2) –
  - (i) at the end of sub-paragraph (b) omit the word "and, "
  - (ii) at the end of sub-paragraph (c), omit the full stop and add ", and", and
  - (iii) after sub-paragraph (c) add the following sub-paragraph –
    - "(d) the maximum number of Eurasian woodcock that may be killed by any person in any period between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 31<sup>st</sup> January inclusive in any year is 35."

**Revocation.**

- 2. Article 1(a) of the Animal Welfare (Amendment) Order, 2017<sup>c</sup> is revoked.

**Interpretation.**

- 3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>d</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or

**Citation and commencement.**

4. This Order may be cited as the Animal Welfare (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2017 and shall come into force on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The Animal Welfare (Requirements for Slaughter, Killing, Euthanasia Etc.) Order, 2014 is amended to –

- add a reference to Eurasian woodcock in paragraph 5(1) of Part II of Schedule 1 (requirements applying to game animals) as it has been added to the prescribed list of game animals to which the requirements for lawful killing apply; and
- add a provision in paragraph 5(2) that the maximum number of Eurasian woodcock that may be killed by any person during any period when these birds can be taken as game (between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 31<sup>st</sup> January inclusive) is 35.

This Order comes into force on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017.
