§11200. Season. A special either-sex deer season shall be legal in designated areas on Andersen Air Force Base when authorized by the Director of Agriculture for the purpose of controlling wildlife populations that present a safety hazard to man or that are beyond the carrying capacity of the deer range. The Director of Agriculture shall announce the opening of the season and number of either-sex permits (tags) that will be issued at least one (1) month in advance. The Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources will determine the number of either-sex permits to issue and issue the permits by a lottery-type selection process. The season shall be open for one calendar month at a time with hunting allowed on days designated by the Commanding Officer, Andersen Air Force Base. Such hunting days will be publicly announced at least ten days in advance.

§11202. Area. The area to be open for either-sex hunting shall be jointly established by the Commanding Officer, Andersen Air Force Base and by the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources. Hunters participating in special hunts will be provided with a map of designated hunting areas prior to the hunt.

§11202. Licenses. All hunters must possess a valid Guam Hunting License and a valid Andersen Air Force Base Hunting License.

§11203. Special Either-Sex Deer Tag. A special either-sex deer tag will be sold and issued to hunters selected to participate in the special hunts. The special either-sex deer tag fee is five dollars (\$5.00). The

special tag will be good only for the calendar month and year for which issued.

§11204. Bag Limit. One deer of either-sex, with or without visible antlers, per special season. Deer taken during this special either-sex hunt will not apply to the hunter's regular license bag limit. Deer taken must be properly tagged at the time and place of kill.

§11205. Selection of Hunters. A limited number of permits (tags) will be issued for special either-sex hunts. The permits will be issued by a lottery-type selection process. Because only a limited number of permits (tags) will be issued, the selected hunters may also be assigned to specific dates and hunting areas by lottery. All hunters wishing to apply for a permit must have the necessary license and register with the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources during normal working hours. Hunters can register for the hunt up through the day prior to the drawing. The drawing will be held between 15 and 20 days prior to the season and the date of the drawing will be announced at least one month prior to the season. Names of the selected hunters will be posted at the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources and at hunting license sales outlets at least 15 days prior to the season. Hunters selected in the lottery may then purchase tag at the Office of the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources, Mangilao. Any tags not claimed within three days of the season will be forfeited and reissued to any qualified hunters on a first come, first served basis.

§11206. Checking Stations. All deer taken during the special either-sex hunt must be processed through a checking station to be established and manned by the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources or Andersen Air Force Base personnel. All deer taken will be subject to inspection and may be weighed, aged and have reproductive tracts, kidneys, lower jaws and some stomach and fecal material collected.

§11207. Other Regulations. Except as specified above, all other provisions of the regular Hunting Regulations apply. Except as specified above, the provisions of Andersen Air Force Base Regulations 126-1 in regard to the conduct of special hunts shall also apply.
