

**FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE (PROHIBITION
OF IMPORTATION) ORDER**

made under section 13

1. This Order may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Prohibition of Importation) Order and shall come into operation on 2nd August, 1954. Citation.

2. In this Order—

Interpretation

“cloven footed animal” means any bull, cow, ox, heifer, calf, sheep, swine, goat or deer;

“other animals” means horses, mares, geldings, colts, fillies, mules, asses, dogs and wild animals;

“fodder” means fodder of any kind brought with cloven footed animals or other animals;

“footwear” means wearing apparel for the feet, and includes boots, shoes, slippers and sandals.

3. Cloven footed animals and meats and their meat products whether fresh, frozen, chilled or dried, fittings, utensils, pens, crates and other animal containers, hides, skins, horns, hair, wool, dehydrated or fresh blood, bones and bonemeal, tankage, hoofs, fodder, straw for forage or packing, milk and other dairy products, and manure and other animal wastes shall not be brought from any of the territories set out in the Schedule into Guyana. Bringing of cloven footed animals into Guyana.

4. Other animals shall not be imported into Guyana from any of the territories set out in the Schedule except under an import licence issued by the Minister. Bringing of other animals.

5. The discharge of sweepings, garbage or other waste material into Guyana or its territorial waters from vessels or aircraft arriving from any of the territories set out in the Schedule is hereby prohibited. Discharge of sweepings.
