

**POULTRY AND POULTRY EGGS (CONDITIONS  
OF IMPORTATION) ORDER**

O. 12/1965

*made under sections 2 and 13*

1. This Order may be cited as the Poultry and Poultry Eggs (Conditions of Importation) Order. Citation.
  
  2. In this Order "poultry" means any live bird of the following species, that is to say, any domestic fowl, turkey, goose, duck, guinea fowl, pheasant or pigeon. Interpretation.
  
  3. For the purposes of this Order—
    - (a) poultry shall be included in the definition of the expression "animal" in section 2 of the Act. Special meanings
    - (b) Newcastle Disease, fowl pest, fowl typhoid and pullorum disease are hereby declared to be diseases within the meaning of the Act.
  
  4. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no poultry or poultry eggs shall be imported into Guyana from any country other than those countries specified in the Schedule. Importation of eggs.  
(2) Poultry or poultry eggs imported from any of the countries specified in the Schedule shall be accompanied by a certificate of health signed by the proper authority in the country of origin to the effect that the poultry or poultry eggs emanated from flocks free from Newcastle Disease, fowl pest, fowl typhoid and pullorum disease.
  
  5. No person shall import into Guyana any container or receptacle used for storing or conveying poultry eggs or poultry feed unless the container or receptacle is new and clean. Importation of containers.
