

FISHING RULES - 1939

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION

Dated the Port Blair, the 31st March, 1939.

No. 13 of 1939 :- Under section 12 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Fisheries Regulation, 1938 (I of 1938), I make the following rules for carrying into effect the provisions of the said regulation. These rules supersede the rules published under the Local Government's Notification No. 22, dated the 11th July, 1934 and all previous orders regulating fishing which are in conflict therewith.

1. These rules shall be called the *Andaman and Nicobar Fishing Rules 1939*. They shall come into force on the 1st April, 1939.

2. In these rules :-

“Regulation” means the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Fisheries Regulation, 1938 (I of 1938).

The phrase “the waters surrounding the Andaman and Nicobar Islands” means the waters extending to a distance of 12 N. miles narrated miles from the coast of these islands, measured from low water mark.

‘Boat’ includes a sampan, dinghy or other water craft propelled by means of oars paddles, sails or mechanical means.

‘Fish’ ‘Fishery Officer’ and ‘Fishing Implement’ shall have the meanings defined in section of the Regulation.

‘Licencing officer’ in relation to fishing in any area within the Aberdeen Tahsil of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands means the Officer-in-charge of the Fisheries Research substation at Port Blair and in relation to fishing in and other area in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands means the Tahsildar of the area”.

For the word “Deputy Commissioner” wherever they occur in the said rules, the words “Licencing Officer” shall be substituted.

3. Unless exepcted by Gazette notifieation, any person wishing to fish in the waters, surrounding the Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall apply to the Licencing Officer for a licence specifying the kinds of fish he intends to catch, the fishing implements he proposes to use, the localities where he wishes to fish, and discription of the boats he desires to use for fishing. The application shall be submitted in Form A attached to these rules.

4. If the Licencing Officer decides to issue a licence to a person it will be granted in Form B and will be subject to the conditions contained in it and to the provisions of these rules. The licence will be for one year from the 1st April and the fee shall be Rs. 2/- for catching fish by device other than bambo i. e. per person per year or part of a year. A licence may be renewed by the Licencing Officer for one year on the expiry of the year for which it is current, on payment of the fee of Rs. 2/- at which the original licence was issued.

5. A register of licence in Form C shall be maintained in the Licencing Officer's Office. Each licence shall be given a separate number.

6. Every person having a licence to fish shall keep that licence with him when so fishing and shall produce it for inspection on the demand of a fishery Officer.

7. Unless exempted by Gazette notification no person shall fish from a boat unless that boat has been licenced by the Licencing Officer for fishing and registered.

8. The owner or other person incharge of a boat which is to be used for fishing, shall apply to the Licencing Officer for registration and licencing, specifying the locality or localities where the boat is to be used for fishing, the fishing implements and methods to be used on and from it, the fish intended to caught, the place or places where the fish will be landed and particulars of the boat. The application shall be submitted in Form, D

9. Before licencing a boat the Licencing officer may require it to be procured for the inspection of the Engineer and Harbour Master with a view to as certain whether it is in good repair, seaworthy and suitable for the use the which it is to be put and for the locality where it is to be used. If the Engineer and Harbour Master is satisfied on these points he shall grant a certificate accordingly on payment of the prescribed fee. The Licencing Officer shall require such a certificate before licencing if the boat is to be propelled by mechanical means

10. If the Licencing Officer decided to issue a licence for a boat it will be granted in Form E and will be subject to the conditions contained in it and to the provisions of these rules. The licence will be for one year from the 1st April and the fee payable shall be according to the scale fixed by the Chief Commissioner which will depend on the class of the boat and the gear to be used. A licence may be renewed by the Licencing Officer for one year on the expiry of the year for which it is current on payment of the prescribed fee

11. When a boat has been licenced it shall be registered in a register in Form F maintained in the Licencing Officer's Office. Copies of the entries made each month shall be forwarded to the Engineer and Harbour Master to be filled in his office for future reference.

11 (A) A Tahsildar acting as a Licencing Officer, may, before issuing or renewing any licence under these rules, consult the officer-in-charge of the Fisheries Research Sub-Station at Port Blair on such technical points as may be considered necessary. A copy of every such licence issued by a Tahsildar and the entries relating to its renewal by him, shall be forwarded by him to the Officer incharge of the Fisheries Research Sub-Station at Port Blair.

NOTE :- The forms under the rules are under preparation and will issue in due course. The scales of fees under the rules will be intimated later.

12 Each licenced boat will be given a separate registration number which number must be painted in the prescribed size and distinctly on each side of the bow of the boat.

13. The licence shall be kept with the boat when fishing is going on and the person incharge shall produce it for inspection on the demand of a Fishery Officer.

14. A person incharge of a licenced boat shall observe the following conditions :-

- 1) Except under stress of weather or for other sufficient reason, he shall not move the boat from the locality or localities specified in the licence.
- 2) He shall keep the registration number painted in each side of the bow of the boat clearly visible.
- 3) If he sights or encounters any other boat which he has reason to believe is illegally engaged in fishing, he shall report the matter immediately to the Licencing Officer or to the Commandant Military Police on his return to Port Blair or to the local Magistrate on his return to a prescribed port.
- 4) He shall permit the boat to be searched at any time by any officer of the Administration, and shall, on demand by that officer produce his licence.
- 5) He shall not permit the boat to be used for the purpose of fishing by any person not in possession of a licence issued under these Rules.
- 6) If so ordered by the Licencing Officer he shall fly a distinguishing flag obtainable from the Engineer and Harbour Master.
- 7) He shall at all times conform to any signals from vessels flying the Government ensign.

15. The right to fish for specified kinds of fish in specified localities of the seas surrounding the Andaman and Nicobar Islands may be leased by the Licencing Officer under the instructions of the Chief Commissioner. The lease may be given on application or by tender or by auction as may be approved by the Chief Commissioner and shall normally be for one year or shorter period as may be prescribed. The leasee shall employ in fishing only persons licenced to fish under rule 4 of the rules and shall use only boats licenced under rule 10 of these rules.

16. Any lease given will be subject to the rights to fish or person exempted from taking out licences by Gazette notification.

17. The lease to be given will be in Form G. The leasee shall deposit with the Licencing Officer such sum in Indian currency notes as may be fixed as security that conditions of the lease will be observed and shall pay amount of premium settled before commencing to fish.

18. Royalty at such rate per ton as the Chief Commissioner may prescribe from time to time on shell including shell confiscated under rules 19 and 22 shall be paid by the leasee to the Licencing Officer.

19. Shells which pass through a 9 centimetre gauge shall not be retained and any catches in which the proportion of such shells more than 5% of the total quantity collected shall be liable to be confiscated.

20. A port clearance certificate for any vessel exporting shell shall not be issued by the Engineer and Harbour Master or other officer prescribed until he has satisfied himself that royalty has been paid in full, that confiscated shells if any, have been removed from the vessel and that the vessel has, if necessary, been searched by the Police.

21. At the end of every trip each boat used by the leasee for fishing shall return to Port Blair or other port prescribed and shall apply to the Engineer and Harbour Master or other officer prescribed to have shell collected measured. If the Engineer and Harbour Master or other Officer prescribed so requires he shall remove the shell from the vessel and stack it on the shore for the purpose of measurement.

22. Except on account of stress of weather or for any other reasonable cause a leasee shall not place or permit to be placed any shell on any other vessel.

23. All the boats used by the leasee for fishing shall return to Port Blair or other port prescribed atleast two days before the date on which the lease expires.

24. If a licensee or leasee commits a breach of any of these rules, his licence or lease shall be liable to be cancelled and any security deposited shall be liable to be forfeited in whole or in part.

25. The Licencing Officer may by order in writing prohibit the catching of fish by means of a net in any specified area for any specified period.

26. A Fishery Officer interposing under Section 6 of the Regulation for the purpose of preventing the commission of an offence, shall forthwith make a report in writing to the Licencing Officer explaining the circumstances in which he interposed. He shall at the same time send to the Licencing Officer a list of the offence, and shall, unless the property seized is perishable or not easily transportable send the property to the Licencing Officer.

27. Property perishable or not easily transportable seized or forfeited either as a result of a conviction under section 5 of the Regulation, or by a Fishery Officer under either section 6 or section 8 of the Regulation, shall be disposed of by order of the convicting Magistrate or of the Fishery Officer making the seizure, as the case may be, to the best advantage of Government. He shall remit the sale proceeds, if any, to the Licencing Officer to be credited to Government.
