

REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION AND LICENSES OF PESTICIDES
(Decree of the Minister of Agriculture No. 406/Kpts/SR.140/6/2004 dated June 14,2004)

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE,

Considering:

- a. that registry holders of pesticide formulas have submitted applications for revoking registration and licenses of pesticides becoming their responsibility;
- b. that pesticides formulas have been replaced by similar formulas;
- c. that based on the above mentioned matters, it is deemed necessary to revoke registration and licenses of the pesticides as meant in letters a and b;

DECIDES :

To stipulate :

THE DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE ON REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION AND LICENSES OF PESTICIDES.

Article 1

(1) To revoke registration and licenses of the pesticides as contained in the attachment to this decree.

(2) The pesticides as meant in paragraph (1) cannot be imported and/or produced in the country anymore.

Article 2

The pesticides as meant in Article 1 already imported and/or produced in the country before the stipulation of this decree still can be distributed and used in accordance with the provisions in force not later than one year from the date of stipulation of this year.

Article 3

In the case of the pesticides as meant in Article 1 being not used up in the period as meant in Article 2, the pesticides shall be taken out from the territory of the Republic of Indonesia or destroyed by their owners or controlling parties in accordance with the provisions in force.

Article 4

The decree shall come into force as from the date of stipulation.
