

THE NATIONAL SURVEY AND MAPPING COORDINATION BOARD
(Decree of the Minister of Finance No.376/KMK.06/2004 dated August 3, 2004)

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE,

Considering:

- a. that pursuant to Article 5 of Government Regulation No.74/1999 on Procedures for Using Non Tax State Revenues Originating from Certain Activities, the agencies receiving non tax state revenues may use part of the non tax state revenues for certain activities after securing approval from the Minister of Finance;
- b. that after studying the application of the Chief of the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board (Bakosurtanal) No. PR.01.02/419A-KA/III/2004 dated March 24, 2004, the Minister of Finance came to the conclusion that Bakosurtanal may use part of funds from non tax state revenues to finance certain activities;
- c. that based on the considerations in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Decree of the Minister of Finance on the Approval of the Use of Part of Funds from Non Tax State Revenues in the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board;

D E C I D E S :

To stipulate:

DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE ON THE APPROVAL OF THE USE OF PART OF FUNDS FROM NON TAX STATE REVENUES IN THE NATIONAL SURVEY AND MAPPING COORDINATION BOARD.

FIRST:

The Minister of Finance shall give approval to the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board

(Bakosurtanal) to use a maximum of 97.38% (ninety-seven point thirty-eight percent) of the funds from non tax state revenues in the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board, as set forth in Government Regulation No.42/2001 on the Tariffs of Non Tax State Revenues Prevailing in the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board.

SECOND:

Part of the funds set forth in the FIRST Dictum may be used to finance technological research and development in the fields of survey and mapping, services involving certain intellectual capacity, law enforcement, and education and training courses.

THIRD:

The agency that has secured approval to use part of funds from non tax state revenues referred to in the FIRST Dictum shall convey a quarterly report to the Director General of Financial Institutions and the Director General of Budget on the total receipt and use of non tax state revenues.

FOURTH:

Part of funds from non tax state revenues approved in the FIRST Dictum shall be put in an annual budget document functioning as a letter of authority.

FIFTH:

In using part of funds from non tax state revenues referred to in the FIRST Dictum, the agency shall coordinate with the Directorate General of Financial Institutions and the Directorate General of Budget.

SIXTH:

The use of part of funds from non tax state revenues in the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board referred to in the FIRST Dictum can any time be reviewed by the Minister of Finance.

SEVENTH:

At the time when this Decree of the Minister of Finance takes effect, Decree of the Minister of Finance No. 618/KMK.06/2001 on Approval of the Use of Part of Funds from Non Tax State Revenues in the National Survey and Mapping Coordination Board shall be declared null and void.

EIGHTH:

This Decree of the Minister of Finance shall come into force as from the date of stipulation.
