

PROCEDURE OF EXPORTING NATURAL GAS THROUGH DISTRIBUTION PIPES
(Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise No. KEP-66/BC/2004 dated August 30, 2004)

THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE,

Considering:

- a. that the procedure of exporting natural gas through distribution pipes is laid down in Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise No. KEP-49/BC/2004 dated July 9, 2004 to take effect as of September 1, 2004;
- b. that after receiving inputs from many sides, the Director General of Customs and Excise felt it necessary to make fundamental changes to the above decision to avoid different interpretations;
- c. that based on the descriptions in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise on the Procedure of Exporting Natural Gas through Distribution Pipes in lieu of Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise No. KEP-49/BC/2004 dated July 9, 2004;

In view of :

1. Law No. 10/1995 on Customs Affairs (Statute Book of 1995 No. 75, Supplement to Statute Book No. 3612);
2. Law No. 22/2001 on Natural Oil and Gas;
3. Decree of the Minister of Finance No. 557/KMK. 04/2002 dated December 31, 2002 on the Customs Procedure in the Export Sector;
4. Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise No. KEP-151/BC/2000 dated July 28, 2003 on Guidelines for Implementing the Customs Procedure in the Export Sector;

D E C I D E S :

To stipulate:

DECISION OF THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ON PROCEDURE OF EXPORTING NATURAL GAS THROUGH DISTRIBUTION PIPES.

Article 1

Hereinafter referred to as the export of natural gas shall be the export of natural gas through distribution pipes from Indonesian customs areas to outside Indonesian customs areas.

Article 2

The export of natural gas through distribution pipes shall be notified and registered by the exporter using an export notification (PEB) to the Customs and Excise Service Office overseeing the place of releasing the relevant natural gas.

Article 3

- (1) The exporter shall put complete and correct data in the PEB including each element of data on the export value of natural gas according to the terms of payment notified.
- (2) The unit used as the measurement unit of natural gas contained in the PEB shall be BBTU (Billion British Thermal Unit).
- (3) The time of releasing the export of natural gas shall be the time when the natural gas passes through the measurement instrument at each last point of measuring natural gas before being exported.

Article 4

- (1) The export volume and value of natural gas contained in the PEB shall be the estimate of the export of natural gas for 1 (one) month starting from the registration date of the PEB.
- (2) The export volume and value of natural gas notified in the PEB specified in paragraph (1) shall be corrected based on the result of the measurement of the export of natural gas using the measurement instrument specified in Article 3 paragraph (3).
- (3) The correction of data on the export of natural gas

specified in paragraph (2) shall be made using a BCF 3.05 document in no more than 3 (three) working days after the period of time specified in paragraph (1) expires.

(4) The data on the export of natural gas used as the basis for filling the BCF 3.05 document shall be attached as an integral part of the BCF 3.05 document.

(5) Difference in the export volume and value of natural gas specified in paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) shall not result in the imposition of administrative sanction.

Article 5

For the purpose of monitoring and supervision and/or if required, the Director General of Customs and Excise can any time:

- a. inspect the natural gas drilling site and/or the natural gas export monitoring and controlling center concerned, and/or
- b. conduct an audit.

Article 6

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When this Decision began to take effect, Decision of the Director General of Customs and Excise No. KEP-49/BC/2004 dated July 9, 2004 on the Procedure of Exporting Natural Gas through Distribution Pipes shall be declared null and void.

Article 7

This Decision shall take effect as of September 1, 2004.

For public cognizance, this Decision shall be announced by placing it in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
