

GOVERNMENT REGULATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
Number: 25 YEAR 2000

CONCERNING CENTRAL AND PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES AS AN
AUTONOMOUS REGION

PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

Considering:

That to implement the stipulations of Article 12 of Law No. 22 Year 1999 concerning Regional Government, it is deemed necessary to enact a Government Regulation concerning Central and Provincial Government as an Autonomous Region for Governance Affairs.

Recalling:

1. Article 5 paragraph (2) of 1945 Constitution
2. Law No. 22 of 1999 concerning Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 60, Year 1999, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3839);
3. Law No. 25 of 1999 concerning Revenue Sharing of Central and Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 72, Year 1999, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3848);

HAS DECIDED

To stipulate:

GOVERNMENT REGULATION CONCERNING CENTRAL AND PROVINCIAL AUTHORITIES
AS AN AUTONOMOUS REGION
Chapter I GENERAL PROVISION

Article 1

In this regulation, meaning of the following terms is:

1. Central Government, hereinafter called Government, is an apparatus of the United Nation of the Republic of Indonesia consisting of President and ministries,
2. Province is an autonomous province,
3. Government Authorities are the rights and power of the government to determine or make policies related to governance affairs.

CHAPTER II GOVERNMENT AND PROVINCE GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES AS AN
AUTONOMOUS REGION

Article 2

- (1) Government authorities cover authorities in foreign political affairs, defense and security, justice, monetary and fiscal affairs, religious and authorities in other fields
- (2) Other authorities as referred to in paragraph (1) cover policies on national planning and control of macro national development, balance of revenues shareing, state administration system and state economic institutions, development and empowerment of manpower, utilisation of natural resources and strategic and high technology, conservation and national standards,

(3) Authorities as referred to in paragraph (2) are categorised according to the following sectors:

1. Forestry and Estate Crops Affairs

- a. Stipulation of criteria and standards for the management of forest, nature reserve-, nature conservation areas, hunting park and estate crops areas
- b. Stipulation of criteria and standards for forest inventory, forest area gazettment and land use planning for forest area, nature reserve-, nature conservation areas and hunting park
- c. Stipulation of forest area and changes in its status and function
- d. Stipulation of criteria and standards for establishment of management unit of forest, nature reserve-, nature conservation areas and hunting park
- e. Undertaking management of nature reserve-, nature conservation areas, hunting park and watershed therein
- f. Preparation of national/macro planning for forestry and estate crops, and general guidelines on land rehabilitation and soil conservation, and preparation of zoning and design, land controlling and primary industry of estate crops
- g. Stipulation of criteria and standard tariff for license fee of forest utilisation business, forest rent tax, reforestation funds, investment funds for forest conservation
- h. Stipulation of criteria and standards for production, processing, quality control, marketing and distribution of forest and estate crops products including seeds, fertiliser and pesticides for forest and estate crops
- i. Stipulation of criteria and standards for license of forest area utilisation, product utilisation and collection, utilisation of environment services, nature tourism utilisation, hunting park utilisation, breeding of flora and fauna, conservation institutions and estate crops business
- j. Granting of licenses for hunting park utilisation, hunting business, breeding of protected flora and fauna and conservation institutions, and undertaking management of nature reserve-, nature conservation areas and hunting parks, including watershed areas therein
- k. Granting of licenses for cross-provincial utilisation of production forest product and nature tourism
- l. Stipulation of criteria and standards for organising forests and management plans, and utilisation, tending, rehabilitation, reclamation, recovery, supervision and control of forest and estate crops areas
- m. Stipulation of criteria and standards for conservation of natural resources and its ecosystem involving protection, preservation and sustainable utilisation of forest and estate crops
- n. Stipulation of norms, procedures, criteria and standards for circulation of plant and wildlife, including the improvement of long-distance migratory wildlife's habitat
- o. Granting licenses for utilisation of flora and fauna which are protected and listed in the appendix to Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES) of Wild Fauna and Flora
- p. Stipulation on criteria and standards, and undertaking safeguarding and controlling hazards in forest and estate crops areas

9. Manpower Affairs

- a. Stipulation of policies for industrial relations, protection of workers and social security of workers
- b. Stipulation of standards of working safety, health, company's hygiene, working environment and ergonomics
- c. Stipulation of guidelines on minimum physical needs
